1. **Contracting Activity:** Department of Veterans Affairs, VISN 4, Pittsburgh Medical Center
Purchase of the St. Jude Medical Velocity ESI Mapping System.

2. **Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:**

Medical Specialty Service Line Cardiology Division, Department of Electrophysiology is requesting the purchase of the Velocity ESI Mapping System to replace the existing ESI mapping system which is eight (8) years old and the operating system and software package are outdated. This will bring us to par with the national standard to allow the Electrophysiologists to diagnose and treat patients with irregular and life threatening heart arrhythmias.

3. **Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:**

Medical Specialty Service Line Cardiology Division is requesting the purchase of the Velocity ESI System to allow the Electrophysiologists to diagnose and treat patients with irregular and life threatening heart arrhythmias. Our current system has reached its useful life expectancy which does not allow for new hardware/software updates. With the current system, one must manually plot all geometric anatomical points prior to performing arrhythmia mapping. Depending on the number of points required for mapping a particular arrhythmia this could take over an hour. With the new Velocity ESI system plotting is done automatically which greatly reduces procedural time. This is extremely important since patients are anesthetized for long periods of time. This is one of a kind system also provides both 2D and 3D imaging capabilities immensely assists the Electrophysiologist in determining abnormal electrical pathways and terminate any potential life threatening arrhythmia. The Velocity ESI system also connects directly to our Hansen Robotic system. In addition, you can use any vendors catheters. No additional supplies will be required from our current usage.




