4. Describe the supply or service to be acquired and the total estimated dollar value:

The Laboratory at the Federal Health Care Center (FHCC) requires the installation of laboratory equipment and software to monitor the processing of the main laboratory phlebotomy patient flow and the Pharmacy at the Federal Health Care Center (FHCC) requires the installation of pharmacy equipment and software to monitor the processing of prescriptions.

Laboratory (FHCC) estimated dollar value is \$46,433.73

Pharmacy (FHCC) estimated dollar value is \$24,786.22

5. List the proposed contractor (name, contact, and phone number) and describe the unique knowledge or capabilities of the proposed contractor:

The existing equipment and software at the Federal Health Care Center (FHCC) is proprietary to ACF Technologies, Inc. and no other hardware or software is compatible. The data from the Laboratory needs to be collected and evaluated effectively for patient care. The Laboratory Q-Flow equipment and software from ACF Technologies, Inc. is the only system compatible and capable of collecting and evaluating data from the current laboratory phlebotomy patient flow system. The Pharmacy Q-Flow equipment and software from ACF Technologies, Inc. is the only system compatible and capable of monitoring the processing of prescriptions at the FHCC pharmacies.

6. Describe your market research efforts and efforts to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as is practicable:

Market research was conducted on NASA SEWP, GSA, NAC, VetBiz, FBO, AbilityOne and the Open Market to see if there was a provider on FSS contract or a Veteran Owned business that could provide the equipment, software, and service from ACF Technologies, Inc. No other contractors were found who could provide the Laboratory Q-Flow or Pharmacy Q-Flow from ACF Technologies, Inc.

7. State why you feel that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable:


Replacing the existing system at the Federal Health Care Center (FHCC) would be cost prohibitive and could have a negative impact on patient care. Past purchases for similar types of hardware and software systems is comparable, 695-C20719 with GE Healthcare Muse software v8.0 was \$31,951.84 and the entire purchase to include training was \$74,471.24. 537-C90370 with AudioCare Systems for the AudioCare reminder software for a total of \$59,190.00. Based on Market Research and past procurement actions, the Contracting Officer has determined the price to be fair and reasonable.

8. Other:

The evaluation, collection, and processing of patient data will be negatively affect patient care if the hardware and software from ACF Technologies, Inc. is not procured since no other system is compatible with the Laboratory Q-Flow.




