1. **Contracting Activity:** Network 23 Contracting Office (NCO 23) – Sioux Falls, 2501 W. 22nd Street, Sioux Falls SD 57105; 636-14-1-4607-0028
2. **Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:** This will be a fixed price contract with the Bruce Alexander to provide necessary labor to conduct work for the Center for Comprehensive Access & Delivery Research and Evaluation, Eli Perencevich, Director and the Veterans Rural Health Resource Center – Central Region Peter Kaboli, Director.
3. **Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:**
Bruce Alexander will provide expertise regarding: VA pharmacy data, pharmacotherapy, and medications on VA formulary in Iowa; development of front-end interfaces and technologies for research data management systems (i.e. SQL, VB, VBA); reconfiguring data between design formats to create unique analytical datasets; and designing, managing, and manipulating research databases to specified research program needs. There is no government furnished property. Estimated Cost: \$50,500. Anticipated period of performance Contract Award Date – 9/30/14.
4. **Statutory Authority Permitting Other than Full and Open Competition:** 41 USC §253(c)(1), as implemented by FAR 6.302-1.

5. **Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):** Bruce Alexander is providing services in support of 2 VA funded Centers. Bruce Alexander was identified as the only contractor that can provide the uniquely requested services the state of Iowa. The work cannot be conducted without utilizing Bruce Alexander. Bruce Alexander has the unique capabilities and expertise combined with the required knowledge to consult on the questions proposed in the Centers. The information and skills required are extremely unique and specialized and only Bruce Alexander has the knowledge and existing capabilities to complete. Going outside a contract with Bruce Alexander would severely hamper the progress of the Centers' activities and impact the timeline of the results.
6. **Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:** Market research was conducted as part of the review process. No other vendor was identified in the funding process as meeting the specific requirements.
7. **Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:** The anticipated cost to the Government is based upon a comparison of previously proposed prices and previous Government and commercial contract prices with current proposed prices for similar services and comparison of proposed prices with prices obtained through market research for the same or similar items. According to the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, National Institutes of Health (NIH), National Center for Biotechnology Information (NCBI) and the Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA), the median calculated cost of conducting 243 studies was \$24,471.00 (interquartile range [IQR], \$11,531.00 - \$63,808.00). The median authors' estimate of study cost was \$10,000.00 (IQR, \$4,000.00 - \$25,000.00). Some funding

was obtained for 72 (29.6%) of the studies. Of studies that were funded, the median amount of funding was \$15,000.00 (IQR, \$5,000.00 - \$66,500.00).
