1. Contracting Activity: Department of Veterans Affairs, Network Contracting Office 16, Gulf Coast Veterans Health Care System, Biloxi Medical Center, on behalf of the ten VISN 16 Stations through the VISN 16 Virtual Library. Justification for Other Than Full and Open Competition for 2237 purchase request number 520-14-2-055-0005.

2. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed: Access to an on-line subscription service for a medical/clinical reference database encompassing over 9,000 unique topic reviews with 7,700 graded recommendations spanning over 45 medical specialties and subspecialties for VISN 16 healthcare providers and other medical professionals is required. A firm-fixed price contract is anticipated for the one-year period of February 1, 2014 through January 31, 2015 with unlimited access for all VISN 16 users from any facility within VISN 16.

3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs: Access to a clinical reference database on-line subscription service is required to provide VISN 16 healthcare providers, medical professionals and other VISN 16 employees with the most current information within their specialties and subspecialties to help them recognize the clinical manifestations of a wide variety of disorders. The database must provide access to the most current options for diagnosis, management, and therapy to include efficacy, dosage, drug interactions, and identification of optimal screening and prevention strategies. The clinical reference database search engine and content must be specifically designed to allow healthcare providers and other medical professionals to answer difficult clinical questions in less than five minutes and must provide the most current information available and be updated at least quarterly. A firm-fixed price contract is anticipated for the one-year period of February 1, 2014 through January 31, 2015 with unlimited access for all VISN 16 users from any facility within VISN 16.

5. Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority): Only One Responsible Source (FAR 6.302-1) – The only source of supply that we are aware of that provides the on-line medical/clinical subscription service containing the amount and depth of information required by our VISN 16 healthcare providers and other medical professionals is UpToDate, Inc. UpToDate, Inc. is the sole proprietor of *UpToDate* content and cannot be accessed without a license obtained directly from them as they do not utilize third party distributors/vendors to sell their subscription services. *UpToDate* content is written and reviewed by over 4,500 recognized specialty experts, and undergoes multiple layers of peer review. *UpToDate* also provides integrated and direct links from their topic search results *Visual DX*. Users are redirected from *UpToDate* directly into *Visual DX* for relevant images. *UpToDate*'s emphasis is on internal medicine and internal medicine subspecialties including cardiology, dermatology, sleep medicine, emergency medicine, endocrinology, rheumatology, gynecology, infectious diseases, oncology gastroenterology, hematology, and hospital medicine. *UpToDate* includes over 5,000 fully integrated drug monographs and a drug-drug/drug-herb interaction modules provided in conjunction with *Lexi-Comp* databases (*Lexi-Drugs*, *Pediatric Lexi-Drugs*, *Lexi-Patient Education*, *Lexi-Natural Products*, and *Lexi-Drug International*). *UpToDate* also provides over 100 evidenced-based medical calculators. *UpToDate* is accredited by the following organizations: AMA, AAFP, AANP, AAP, ACEP, AOA and CFPC. It is the Contracting Officer's experience in purchasing various sources of published material (both on-line and hard copy) that each individual company has access to specialized materials that others normally do not carry. While some companies may have access to some of the same material, it is rare where multiple companies carry the exact materials as another company. UpToDate, Inc. is the only known firm capable of providing the required on-line subscription services described above without the Veteran's Health Administration experiencing substantial duplication of cost that could not be expected to be recovered through competition. This on-line medical/clinical reference material has been identified as necessary in order for the VISN 16 healthcare providers and other medical professionals to accomplish their jobs and fulfill the VA's mission to serve our country's Veterans.

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable: The undersigned Contracting Officer ran a VetBiz Registry Database inquiry under NAICS Code 519130 which revealed zero matches for SDVOSB's and VOSB's providing these types of reference materials. A NAICS search was attempted in SAM (formerly CCR) but with zero results; however, the NAICS Code 519130 was still verified with *UpToDate*. A search was then conducted in SBA Dynamic Database using NAICS Code 519130—Internet Publishing and Broadcasting and Web Search Portals revealed 2,415 small business sources. However, we do not believe that any of these small business sources of supply can provide the same number or breadth of topic reviews provided by *UpToDate*. The undersigned Contracting Officer also checked other available on-line clinical (medical) reference material in the commercial market (*Dynamed*, *FIRSTConsult*, *ACP Pier*, *MD Consult* (which the National Library Office subscribes to for use by all VAs), *Stat!Ref* (which VISN 16 already subscribes to), *Harrisons On-line*, *SUMSearch*, and *Trip Plus*) but none of these reference materials appear to come even close to supplying the amount and level (depth) of medical reference material required by VISN 16 medical professionals. This requirement will be posted on the Federal Business Opportunities website. If there are any other vendors in the commercial

market that can possibly meet the above requirements, we will immediately contact those companies to discuss our requirements to see if in-fact they can meet them. We will continue to monitor other sources of supply in the commercial market (both open market and on GSA's Federal Supply Schedules) to see if the Government's requirements can possibly be met by other companies.

7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable: Because it appears that there are not published price lists available for this subscription service, we will have to seek copies of contracts, purchase orders, or invoicing where these same subscription services were sold to similar size medical organization as that of VISN 16 (based upon inpatient and outpatient admissions). It is fully anticipated adequate information can be obtained so that price far and reasonableness can be achieved and documented.

8. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted: A search of the SBA Dynamic Database using NAICS Code 519130—Internet Publishing and Broadcasting and Web Search Portals revealed 2,415 small business sources. In addition to the above, the undersigned also ran a VetBiz Registry inquiry under NAICS Code 519130 which revealed zero matches for SDVOSB's and VOSB's providing these types of reference materials. The undersigned also checked other available on-line clinical (medical) reference material in the commercial market (*Dynamed, FIRSTConsult, ACP Pier, MD Consult* (which the National Library Office subscribes to for use by all VAs), *Stat!Ref* (which VISN 16 already subscribes to for use by all VISN 16 facilities), *Harrisons On-line, SUMSearch, and Trip Plus*) but none of these reference materials appear to come even close to supplying the amount and level (depth) of medical reference material required by VISN 16 medical professionals. It is the Contracting Officer's experience in purchasing various sources of published material (both on-line and hard copy) that each individual company has access to specialized materials that others normally do not carry. We will continue to monitor other sources of supply in the commercial market (both open market and on GSA's Federal Supply Schedules) to see if the Government's requirements can possibly be met by other companies.

A Statement of the Actions, if any, the Agency May Take to Remove or Overcome any Barriers to Competition before Making subsequent acquisitions for the supplies or services required: If these same (or similar) requirements are required in the future, they will also be posted on the Federal Business Opportunities website unless the requirement can be filled

through GSA's Federal Supply Schedules at which time the requirement would be posted on GSA's eBuy website. If we find any other vendors in the commercial market that can possibly meet the above requirements, we will immediately contact those companies to discuss our requirements to see if in-fact they can meet them. We will also continue to monitor other sources of supply in the commercial market (both open market and on GSA's Federal Supply Schedules) to see if the Government's requirements can possibly be met by other companies.


