1. **Contracting Activity:** Network 23 Contracting Office (NCO 23) – Sioux Falls, 2501 W. 22nd Street, Sioux Falls SD 57105; 636-14-1-4406-0001
2. **Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:** This will be a fixed price contract with the University of Iowa, Department of Psychology who will provide necessary labor to conduct work on the Veterans Rural Health Resource Center – Central Region projects entitled “Development and Implementation of a Cancer Survivorship Care Plan for Rural Veterans” and “Mixed- Methods Evaluation of Challenges and Opportunities in the Care of Rural Veterans throughout the Central Region (ROAD Trip) Phase II”, Bryant Howren, PhD, Project Leader; and the Office of Rural Health funded project, “Dissemination of a Tailored Tobacco Quitline for Rural Veteran Smokers”, Mark Vander Weg, PhD, Project Leader.
3. **Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency’s Needs:**
The University of Iowa, Department of Psychology will provide expertise in health and well being issues related to cancer survivors and their care and recovery, smoking cessation counseling, telephone based therapy delivery, and treatment strategies for chronic illness. There is no government furnished property. Estimated Cost: \$85,743. Anticipated period of performance Contract Award Date – 9/30/14.
4. **Statutory Authority Permitting Other than Full and Open Competition:** 41 USC §253(c)(1), as implemented by FAR 6.302-1.

5. **Demonstration that the Contractor’s Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):** The University of Iowa, Department of Psychology was specifically identified in the funding of this Office of Rural Health project. Going outside the University of Iowa, Department of Psychology would not meet the terms and conditions in the project. The work cannot be conducted without utilizing the University of Iowa, Department of Psychology. The University of Iowa is providing services in support of Dr. Howren’s and Dr. Vander Weg’s VA funded research projects. The University of Iowa has the unique capabilities and expertise combined with the required knowledge to consult on the questions proposed in this project. These are very specialized procedures that only the University of Iowa has the knowledge to complete. Going outside the University of Iowa would severely hamper the progress of research and impact the timeliness of research results.
6. **Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:** Market research was conducted as part of the review process. No other vendor was identified in the funding process as meeting the specific requirements.
7. **Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:** The anticipated cost to the Government is based upon a comparison of previously proposed prices and previous Government and commercial contract prices with current proposed prices for similar services and comparison of proposed prices with prices obtained through market

research for the same or similar items. According to the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services, National Institutes of Health (NIH), National Center for Biotechnology Information (NCBI) and the Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA), the median calculated cost of conducting 243 studies was \$24,471.00 (interquartile range [IQR], \$11,531.00 - \$63,808.00). The median authors' estimate of study cost was \$10,000.00 (IQR, \$4,000.00 - \$25,000.00). Some funding was obtained for 72 (29.6%) of the studies. Of studies that were funded, the median amount of funding was \$15,000.00 (IQR, \$5,000.00 - \$66,500.00).
