2. **Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:**

The requirement for the contractor to use a "Guldmann" patient lift for the Enhance Patient Environment (Bldg. 320 – Pod D) - Project No.:552-14-101. The cost of the Guldmann patient lift components is estimated at \$14,570.00.

3. **Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:**

As part of a project to Enhance the Patient Environment in Bldg. 320 – Pod D at the Dayton VAMC, a patient lift must be installed. Patient lifts are necessary to assist in safe patient handling throughout the medical center.

The Guldmann GH3 patient lifts are used throughout the medical center to achieve safe patient handling practices and is the fastest lift on the market which makes it convenient and user friendly.

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:

All patient lifts that are used at the Dayton VAMC are by Guldmann. Guldmann must continue to be used to ensure that all of the specifications for lifting speed and maximum weight capacity are met.

7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:

The best interests of the government are served through the use of this product. The pricing will be provided as part of equipment available in the commercial marketplace. The price will be determined to be fair and reasonable to the government based on competition. The cost associated with this initiative is estimated at \$14,570.00.

8. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted:

No other brands of ceiling lifts offer the specifications for lifting speed and maximum weight capacity in a single product. Other brands do not have integrated scales or statistical function for management use as the Guldmann.

No action can be taken in the circumstance due to the equipment being under warranty and the need to maintain this warranty. The VA will continue to review the marketplace during future construction initiatives to determine if products have become available which meet the needs of the VA.
