2. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:

Requirement of contractor to use "Valcom" overhead paging system components for the paging system referenced in Section 23 09 23, for the Patient Environmental Enhancement (Bldg. 320- Pod D) – Project No.: 552-14-101.

3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

As a part of the project the paging system will be upgraded and will incorporate hardware with a Valcom platform. Valcom is used on all new and existing overhead paging components of this system. The estimated cost of the Valcom components needed for the paging system in this project is approximately \$2,800.00.

This contract is being procured on a sole brand basis due to the need for the overhead paging system to be integrated completely and seamlessly. The Valcom overhead paging system is currently being used throughout the facility. It is necessary for the paging system in this project to integrate seamlessly with the current system, thus justifying sole brand of these Valcom components.

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:

The overhead paging system that is used at the Dayton VAMC is a Valcom based system. In order for the system to operate seamlessly and to be fully integrated the overhead paging system components must be Valcom. There are multiple sources for these controllers; Valcom simply refers to the manufacturer of the hardware.

7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:

There have been previous purchases for the Valcom based system. The Contracting Officer will be able to determine a fair and reasonable pricing based on previous procurement history and commercial pricing. A fair and reasonable price determination will be made by the Contracting Officer based on competition.

8. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted:

Market research has been previously conducted for prior projects, concerning this subject. This product is open for the public to purchase, this allows any contractor who has been properly trained on the product to install. The certification classes are also open to the public. There is at least one contractor in the area who currently can install these products.
