1. Contracting Activity:

Department of Veterans Affairs, VISN 8, Miami VA Healthcare Systems, Bruce W. Carter Medical Center requests authorization to proceed with other than full and open competition to acquire services for purchase request 546-14-1-6591-0042.

2. Nature and/or Description of Action Being Processed:

This is a request for other than full and open competition for the procurement and construction services for the renovation of Q.M. area, at the Miami Veterans Affairs Healthcare System.

Proposed award for this procurement is to Unlimited Service Associates, Inc., a Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) concern.

3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

Work covered under this acquisition consists of Purchasing and installing modular partitions in 2E109 for two offices, with two doors. Walls must be up to existing ceiling and maintain sprinkler/air conditioning, lighting coverage. Office modular walls will be as-build for room applications. Walls will match existing wall system color and doors are to have a clear finish. Vendor must come to verify dimensions required to install walls. Walls are to be built within working area occupied by VA personnel. In addition, project consists of tying in lights with new switches and re-working required air supplies and returns as necessary at the Miami Veterans Affairs Healthcare System. The estimated cost of this project is below \$25,000.00. The period of performance is 60 calendar days.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other than Full and Open Competition:

Authorized or Required by Statute FAR 6.302-5.

5. Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):

Authority under 38 USC 8127-8128 (Sections 502 and 503 of Public Law (P.L.) 109-461), FAR Part 6.302-5(b) (6), and VAAR 819.7007

Sole Source awards to service disabled veterans-owned small business concerns.

(a) A contracting officer may award contracts to SDVOSB concerns on a sole source basis provided:

- (1) The anticipated award price of the contract (including options) will not exceed \$5 million;
 - (2) The requirement is synopsisized in accordance with FAR part 5;
 - (3) The SDVOSB concern has been determined to be a responsible contractor with respect to performance; and
 - (4) Award can be made at a fair and reasonable price.
- (b) The contracting officer's determination whether to make a sole source award is a business decision wholly within the discretion of the contracting officer. A determination that only one SDVOSB concern is available to meet the requirement is not required.

The anticipated award amount is below \$25,000.00. A special notice announcing the contract action was posted to FEDBIZOPPs in January 22, 2014. A separate determination of the contractor's responsibility has been made in accordance with FAR 9. A sole source award is proposed pending negotiation of a fair and reasonable price.

Unlimited Service Associates is immediately available for the execution of the work. The contractor's past performance on Miami's Veterans Affairs projects has been outstanding with very positive results to the Medical Center and using services involved. The contractor has completed other project at the Miami Veteran Administration Healthcare System such as to (1) Repair M.I.C.U. Ductwork in MICU Ward, (2) Replace Loading Docks Levelers and (3) Renovate VCS Starbucks' Coffee Area. The contractor has completed work at Tampa Veteran Affairs medical Center such as upgrading (1) T77 and T78 Trailers, (2) Angio Plasma Suite, (3) M.R.I./ Laboratory and (4) Upgrading the Fisher House Life Safety Standards. The CO is recommending an SDVOSB sole source to Unlimited Service Associates, Inc., based on the aforementioned.

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable

While there are other contractors in Vetbiz.gov, a determination that only one SDVOSB concern is available to meet the requirement is not required per the authorities cited in paragraph 5.

The Contracting Officer has determined that Unlimited Services Associates, Inc., is qualified as a SDVOSB; and will provide superior construction services based on the company's past performance on various projects completed at Miami Veteran Affairs Medical Center.

7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:

Based on the authorities cited in this justification, a sole source award to subject contractor is proposed pending negotiation of a fair & reasonable price. It is expected

negotiations with result in a cost which compares favorably to the independent Government Estimate.

8. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted:

The VIP database was queried in accordance with VAAR 810.001, Market Research policy. The Unlimited Service Associates, Inc., is listed in the VIP database along with other multiple SDVOSB concerns.

9. Any Other Facts Supporting the Use of Other than Full and Open Competition:

Per authorities cited in paragraph 5, the contracting officer's determination whether to make a sole source award is a business decision wholly within the discretion of the contracting officer.

10. Listing of Sources that Expressed, in Writing, an Interest in the Acquisition):

Multiple SDVOSBs exist in the VIP database; however, the contracting officer's determination whether to make a sole source award is a business decision wholly within the discretion of the contracting officer. A determination that only one SDVOSB concern is available to meet the requirement is not required. The CO has determined a sole source award is in the best interest of the VA.

11. A Statement of the Actions, if any, the Agency May Take to Remove or Overcome any Barriers to Competition before Making subsequent acquisitions for the supplies or services required:

Any future SDVOSB sole source awards in the best interest of the VA will be rotated to other SDVOSB's determined responsible.

12. Requirements Certification: I certify that the requirement outlined in this justification is a Bona Fide Need of the Department of Veterans Affairs and that the supporting data under my cognizance, which are included in the justification, are accurate and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.
