The proposed contract action is a sole source, firm fixed-price, delivery order issued to Cepheid, a large business, VA NAC contract V797P-5967X, for reagents to utilize the instrumentation that was purchased in support of the National MRSA initiative. The requested reagents are needed for the existing MRSA system. Replacing the existing vendor at this juncture, would negatively impact the level of care/services we currently provide to residents within the facility as it would require different equipment.

The Department of Veterans Affairs, VA Health Care System (VISN 10), Dayton VA Medical Center has a requirement for 18 Genexpert MRSA test kits for the VA Medical Center, total cost of [REDACTED]. These kits are used for the detection of the MRSA virus in admitted patients.

- Decreases the increase in hospital stays due to nosocomial infections.

Cepheid provides the only reagents that can be used for their GeneXpert system.
