Q1. Physical address of where the fuel is to be delivered.

A1. *1615 Woodward Street, Austin, Texas 78744*

Q2. Tank size(s) and number of tanks - are there any special fitting required and/or length of hoses.

A2. *30 foot hose and 3 inch fittings*

Q3. Can a gravity fed fueling system service the tanks or is a pump system required?

A3. *A pump system is required*

Q4. What will be the average quantity per order?

A4. *FAR 52.216-19 ORDER LIMITATIONS (OCT 1995)*

(a) Minimum order. When the Government requires supplies or services covered by this contract in an amount of less than 500 gallons, the Government is not obligated to purchase, nor is the Contractor obligated to furnish, those supplies or services under the contract.

(b) Maximum order. The Contractor is not obligated to honor—

(1) Any order for a single item in excess of 15,000 gallons;

(2) Any order for a combination of items in excess of 115,000 gallons; or

(3) A series of orders from the same ordering office within one days that together call for quantities exceeding the limitation in paragraph (b)(1) or (2) of this section.

Q5. What type of transport can be employed TT or TW?

A5. *A tank truck is the only method of transportation to be used.*

Q6. What type of fuel?

A6. *Dyed Diesel Fuel*

Q7. Price index which your organization normally employs?

A7. *None.*

Q8. What are the payment procedures?

A8. *52.232-34, Payment by Electronic Funds Transfer—Other than System for Award Management (Jul 2013) (31 U.S.C. 3332).*
