Background

The rehab equipment can assist individuals with various disabilities including, but not limited to stroke, spinal cord injury, Parkinson's disease, traumatic brain injury, multiple sclerosis, and obesity. At the VA, we specialize in working with patients recovering from musculoskeletal injuries, diseases, physical disabilities and/or the effects of deconditioning that come paired with a sedentary lifestyle

The rehab equipment has been an integral part of patients' recovery. From the early days after injury, the equipment offers patients an opportunity to improve their circulation, range-of-motion, Flexibility and overall strength and endurance, therefore, enhancing their independence and self-efficacy. Complications from disuse syndrome such as muscle weakness, loss of endurance, limitations in joint range of motion, cardiovascular de-conditioning, and redistribution of body fluids with unfavorable changes in body composition, frequently become a greater problem for the individual. An additional benefit to the regular use of this equipment will provide a decrease in the development of the degenerative changes and secondary complications that typically follow a disabling condition. We also use the rehab equipment to correct muscular imbalances, postural deviations, and movement dysfunctions. As these variables are corrected, patients report a decrease in their perceived pain levels.

Delivery of the following items required:

D719	709 Plus, 5 Channel Combo Stim Light Ultrasound - must be able to deliver 3-Frequency Ultrasound, 7 Stim waveforms (including IFC, Premod, Biphasic, Russian, High Volt, Microcurrent, Direct Current, and Fixed Frequency IFC/Premod, and the option of adding Tri-Wave Light Therapy.	1
DSH05	5cm2 Dynatron Soundhead – must be able to provide 1, 2, and 3 MHz frequencies for the greatest flexibility in depth of treatment.	1
DCP3	Tri-wave light probe – must be able to deliver any combination of 3-wavelengths of light (red, infrared, and blue) using the Tri-Wave Light Probe or 2 robust 5 in x 7 in Tri-Wave Light Pads.	1
DLP3	Tri-wave light pad – must be able to deliver any combination of 3-wavelengths of light (red, infrared, and blue) using the Tri-WaveLight Probe or 2 robust 5 in x 7 in Tri-Wave Light Pads.	1
D71CART	Dynatron Solaris Plus Cart – must have 3 large drawers big enough to store cords, pads, probes, electrodes, and a myriad of treatment supplies. Constructed with a low center of gravity to prevent tipping (each caster has a weight tolerance of 125 lbs.)	1
