1. **Contracting Activity:** Department of Veterans Affairs, NCO 10, Chillicothe, Ohio Medical Center
2. **Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:** Brand Name Justification for construction project to renovate the second floor of building 212 for project 538-14-100 entitled Consolidate Admin Space and Resolve Environmental Conditions, B212CD. In addition to rehabilitation of existing office areas work includes the complete renovation of four restrooms, addition of two small break rooms and a communications closet. HVAC improvements include adding forced-air heating/cooling with ventilation. The project also includes replacement of certain electric components and extensive roof repair. This will be a firm fixed price contract and will be awarded as a new contract.
3. **Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:** The existing VAMC Chillicothe campus Fire Detection equipment is comprised of a Simplex-Grinnell System that was recently installed across the campus. The necessity to maintain consistency with Simplex Grinnell equipment is imperative for the continued communication of said Fire Detection System. The Fire Detection Equipment that will be provided under this project is covered by a manufacturers comprehensive warranty program. In order for this program to be in effect however, the contractor installing the equipment must be certified by the manufacturer. This does not limit the ability for multiple vendors to provide the work as Simplex-Grinnell does not limit availability on a territorial basis. There are numerous Simplex-Grinnell certified vendors who can provide the work described in the project.

It is imperative that the continued communication of the Fire Detection System be consistent for the safety of the facility. This equipment is covered by a comprehensive warranty program. This equipment must be installed by a contractor certified by the manufacturer.

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable: The facility has requirements for this equipment to be covered by the warranty contract.
7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable: It is in the best interest of the government to use this product. The pricing is in line with pricing provided to the vendor's other commercial customers, and is considered to be fair and reasonable. The pricing for the entire project will be determined to be fair and reasonable to the government based on competition and commercial price lists as applicable. There are numerous Simplex-Grinnell certified vendors who can provide the work described in the project.
8. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted: The Simplex-Grinnell equipment has been approved for the VA system and installed across campus and the network needs to maintain standardization in order to work efficiently. Also the Simplex-Grinnell equipment can be purchased from numerous certified vendors.
