2. Nature and/or Description of Action Being Processed: The requirement of contractor to utilize a specific elevator lift gate Courion to retrofit the existing equipment for the Renovate Patient Kitchen B411 Project No: 552-14-102.

Demonstration of Contractors Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (Applicable Authority): The elevator lift gate from Courion is being used since the existing equipment is being retrofitted with the above mentioned gate. The process helps in maintaining the warranty on the entire product/equipment.
6. Description of Efforts Made to Ensure that offers are solicited from as many Potential Sources as deemed practicable: Courion is the manufacture of the lift gate with dealers all across the country. The entire project will be competed as an Invitation for Bid (IFB) which will encourage competitive pricing for the lift gate.

Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable: An internet search showed authorized dealers for the Courion Lift Gate which will encourage competition. As stated above the entire project will be competed as an IFB which will also encourage competitive pricing on the lift gate.
8. Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Result, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted: An internet search of the Courion Lift Gate was conducted. It was found that there are authorized dealers to sell and install the gates. This should encourage competition in the bidding process.


