

- 1: Specification Sheet 090600-16 refers to "Floorscape Design" on the VCT & LVT for the "MFG Name/No." Where is the "Floorscape Design" located to get the details for these finishes?

Response: The "Floorscape Design" consists of a floor pattern plan reflecting multiple colors used within the same material specified. The color name and number represent the different colors used from that product throughout the project. In Specification section 09 06 00, the references to VCT-1 and LVT-1 represent field colors. The references to VCT-2 and LVT-2 represent accent colors. A final "Floorscape Design" drawing will be provided, but for bidding purposes, refer to Drawing sheets AD101, AE108, and AE109 for floor finish material locations and anticipate areas indicated to receive VCT and LVT (LVT is also identified and SVT - solid vinyl flooring) floor finishes to be provided with a field color and an accent color (border and/or decorative accents), as identified in Specification section 09 06 00.

- 2: Specification Sheet 090600-16 shows finish "RT" "To Be determined." Has a finish been selected or is there a specific material allowance that should be used?

Response: The Rubber Tile (RT) shown in Specification section 09 06 00, page 16, is to be Johnsonite Solid Color Rubber Tile Flooring, Raised Square texture, 24-inch by 24-inch size. The color is to be determined from the manufacturer's full line of standard colors. Rubber Stair Treads (RST) shown in Specification section 09 06 00, page 15, are to be Johnsonite Solid Color Rubber Stair Treads, Raised Square texture, compatible with the selected rubber floor tile. The color is to be determined from the manufacturer's standard color palettes A and B lines. Note that the Rubber Base (RB) shown in Specification section 09 06 00, page 15, is to be Johnsonite Millwork Wall Base Diplomat, #66 Either Ore. Note that the Resilient Molding shown in Specification section 09 06 00, page 15, is to match Johnsonite Millwork Wall Base Diplomat, #66 Either Ore.

- 3: Drawing AE601 Shows "SVT" for the finish legend. Is this the same material as the LVT that is called out in specification 090600-16 as LVT?

Response: Yes, LVT and SVT represent the same material and their references are interchangeable.
