2. Nature of the Action Being Processed:

The nature of the action being processed is a firm-fixed price purchase order using 0162 Medical Facilities appropriated funds.

3. Description of Supplies or Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

This procurement under PR # 653-14-4-104-0177 is for mopping and cleaning supplies for FMS (138) at the Roseburg VA campus.

The overall requirement encompasses a variety of mopping and cleaning supplies. The estimated value of this contract award is \$45,755.00.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Restriction in Competition:

The statutory authority for restricting competition among a single service-disabled veteran-owned small business concern is 15 U.S.C. 631, Sec. 36, as implemented by VAAR 819.7007.

This justification is where in accordance with FAR 6.001(a), acquisitions conducted under FAR 13 for SAP are exempt from the requirements of FAR Part 6, but still require a justification using the format of FAR 6.303-2, IAW the VHA Procurement Manual SOP for Other Than Full And Open Competition, dated 11/1/2012.

5. Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):

In accordance with the requirements of VAAR 819.7007 for award of sole-source contracts to service-disabled veteran-owned small businesses:

- The anticipated award price of the contract will not exceed \$5 million (VAAR 819.7007(a)(1));
- This total price of this contract award will not meet the thresholds identified in FAR part 5 for required synopses of proposed contract actions (VAAR 819.7007(a)(2));
- The SDVOSB concern has a reputation of responsible past-performance with the requesting agency (VAAR 819.7007(a)(3).
- The proposed price offered by the contractor is fair and reasonable (VAAR 819.7007(a)(4);
- In accordance with VAAR 819.7007(b), *"The contracting officer's determination whether to make a sole source award is a business decision wholly within the discretion of the contracting officer. A determination that only one SDVOSB concern is available to meet the requirement is not required."*
- The contractor selected for award of this contract action is a VIP-verified Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business concern in accordance with VAAR 819.7007(c).

6. Description of Efforts Made to Ensure that Offers are Solicited from As Many Potential Sources as Deemed Practicable IAW FAR 13.104:
