1. **Contracting Activity:** This justification for Other Than Full and Open Competition is prepared by the Department of Veterans Affairs Network Contracting Office 6 on behalf of the Veteran Affairs medical Center in Fayetteville, NC in support of 565-14-3-1019-0020..
2. **Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:** This justification provides rationale for soliciting using a brand name only description for the Audioscan Verifit2 System. A competitive RFQ will be issued. A firm fixed price Purchase Order is planned with a required delivery date of June 2015.
3. **Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:** Purchase of the following items: Audio Scan Verifit2, 9 each; Etymonic Design NOAH, 9 each; External speaker, 9 each; shipping and labor.

5. **Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority):** The Audiology Clinic has the Audio Scan Verifit2 system in use at the Fayetteville VA Medical Center. The Audioscan Verifit2 is used to verify/ensure compliance with National Hearing Aid standards of practice. In an effort to maintain standardization, the exact same equipment is requested for the new Fayetteville HCC. Audiologists will be conducting the same type of evaluations at both sites of care, and they are familiar with both the hardware and software associated with this system. Both the clinical staff and engineering (Bio-Med) personnel have been trained and have experience and confidence with this equipment. Standardizing between the Fayetteville VA facilities presents a cost benefit and enhanced personnel productivity because extensive retraining will not be required on a different brand of equipment. This minimizes disruptions and allows for smooth and efficient operation within the clinic, which enhances customer service and patient satisfaction. Introduction of another manufacturer's equipment would result in duplication of training and equipment support costs not expected to be recovered through competition.

6. Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable: A sources sought notice was posted August 25 thru 27, 2014 seeking potential sources of the Audioscan Verifit System. Two small businesses responded . As a result a competitive RFQ will be posted, as a 100% set aside for small business.
7. Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable: Price will be determine fair and reasonable based on competition.


