**4. Describe the supply or service to be acquired and the total estimated dollar value:**

Brand Name Only acquisition of (3) Stryker S3 Patriot Beds and accessories for the Spinal Cord Injury Center at the Clement J. Zablocki VA Medical Center, in Milwaukee, WI. The total estimated dollar amount is \$31,466.46

**5. List the proposed contractor (name, contact, and phone number) and describe the unique knowledge or capabilities of the proposed contractor:**

The Stryker S3 Patriot Beds are available from American Medical Depot (Dwayne Coombs (305)364-0888). The Stryker S3 Patriot Beds are the only hospital beds to offer a retractable frame at the head end of the bed. This allows for the patient to remain in nearly the same position when the head end is raised, which eliminates the need to re-adjust the position any time the head-end is moved. The hospital beds are also compatible with the current television arms and the Jeron nurse call system used by the Spinal Cord Injury Center. The environmental control units currently in use at the Spinal Cord Injury Center are also programmed specifically for the Stryker S3 Patriot Beds.

**6. Describe your market research efforts and efforts to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as is practicable:**

Market research was conducted on Unicom, GSA, NAC, NASA SEWP, FBO, VetBiz, AbilityOne, SBA, eCMS, and the Open Market. Market research has shown that other hospital beds do not offer all the salient features required by the facility.

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**7. State why you feel that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable:**

The IGCE indicates that the product pricing is congruent with American Medical Depot's ECAT contract SPM2DH-13-D-8206 awarded by Defense Logistics Agency, Philadelphia, PA. The ECAT contract has an expiration date of March 19, 2018. This acquisition will be competed as a brand name only, small business set-aside to ensure competition and reasonable pricing.
