The lease of this equipment is under contract, but the repair of this scope is not. In order to return this scope to patient care services this repair is necessary. Olympus does not authorize any other vendor to repair scopes that are on lease to government or commercial entities. "Accordingly, Olympus Corporation is the only firm capable of providing the supplies and services described in Section II above without the Veteran's Health Administration experiencing substantial duplication of cost that could not be expected to be recovered through competition and unacceptable delays in fulfilling its requirements."
6. **Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:** As Olympus America is the only vendor able to perform these repairs, no other market research was conducted.
