

Other Than Full and Open Competition (>\$150K)

1. **Contracting Activity:** Department of Veterans Affairs, NCO 22, Veteran Affairs Greater Los Angeles Healthcare System (VAGLAHS). The purchase request number is 691-15-1-207-0002.
2. **Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:** This Justification and Approval authorizes and approves the award of a sole source procurement for Preventive Maintenance Services for Stryker Patient Care Beds and Stretchers in accordance with FAR Part 13.5 Test Programs for Certain Commercial Items and specifically FAR 13.501 Special Documentation Requirements, where acquisitions conducted under Simplified Acquisition Procedures are exempt from the requirements of FAR Part 6, but still require a justification using the format of FAR 6.303-2. This is a new procurement and the contract contemplated will be a firm-fixed price base plus and four (4) one year option contract with Stryker Corporation.
3. **Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:** VAGLAHS requires Preventive Maintenance Services for Stryker Patient Care Beds and Stretchers that includes but is not limited to full diagnostic checks of the electrical, casters, jacks, bases, siderails, and litter in accordance with maintenance manuals, cleaning, inspecting, Lubricating, equipment tune-up, hardware tightening and replacing, alignment adjusting, equipment evaluation, identifying needed repairs, and detecting potential problems. Repair includes repair and/or replacement the following items: all labels, worn wheel bearings, sidearm pins, knobs, and springs, head-end release handles, wheels, safety u-bar springs, safety release levers, release handle grips, foot-end release handles, leg return, ratchet bar springs, lift handles, crutch tips, scuff strips, fastener post, and hardware. The total estimated value of this acquisition of a base plus and four (4) one year options is [REDACTED], [REDACTED] with an estimated period of performance (POP) of 12/01/2014 – 11/30/2019.
4. **Statutory Authority Permitting Other than Full and Open Competition:** The authority for applying the Commercial Test Program of FAR 13.5 is (Section 4202 of the Clinger-Cohen Act of 1996) and is implemented by for restricting competition on this procurement via FAR 13.106-1(b)(2).




