Number	Questions	Answers
1.	Will the government allow an extension for the Past Performance Risk Assessment Questionnaire submission of the amended proposal until Friday, January 16, 2015?	Past Performance Questionnaires that will be submitted by the Offeror are required to be submitted by Tuesday, January 13, 2015 at 12PM EST.
2.	Is the parent company allowed to submit Past Performance citations in addition to the max number required from the prime contractor? If so, what is the maximum number of citations allowed by the parent company?	Prime Offerors and major subcontractors may submit instances for its parent company or affiliates who are anticipated to participate meaningfully in contract performance; however, the Offeror is still limited to the requirements of the solicitation at Section L, Volume II – Past Performance: “Prime Offerors shall submit up to three (3) instances and major subcontractors shall submit up to two (2) instances of Federal, State or Commercial contracts (prime contracts, task/delivery orders, and/or major subcontracts in performance during the past three years from the solicitation date of issuance), which are relevant to the efforts required

		by this solicitation.”
3.	Please clarify regarding the issue of “meaningful participation”. Is the Government requesting a quantitative measure such as a percentage or rather a qualitative description of the parent company’s work in support of NG task orders?	As stated in Amendment A00004, the Offeror shall include a narrative adequately describing the anticipated meaningful participation during performance of this contract.
4.	Will the Government permit offerors to make updates to the other volumes in addition to Volume II – Past Performance?	No, as stated in Amendment A00004, this is not an opportunity to revise any other aspect of the Offeror’s proposal and any changes to other volumes will not be considered.
