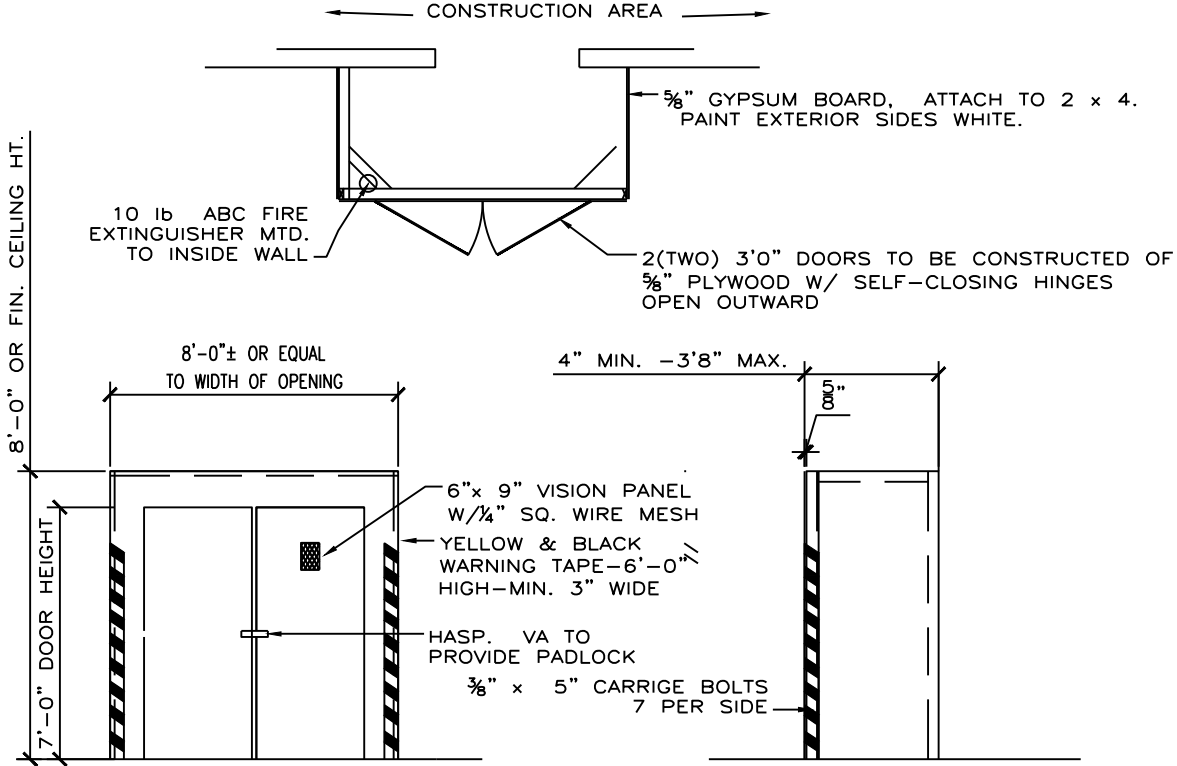
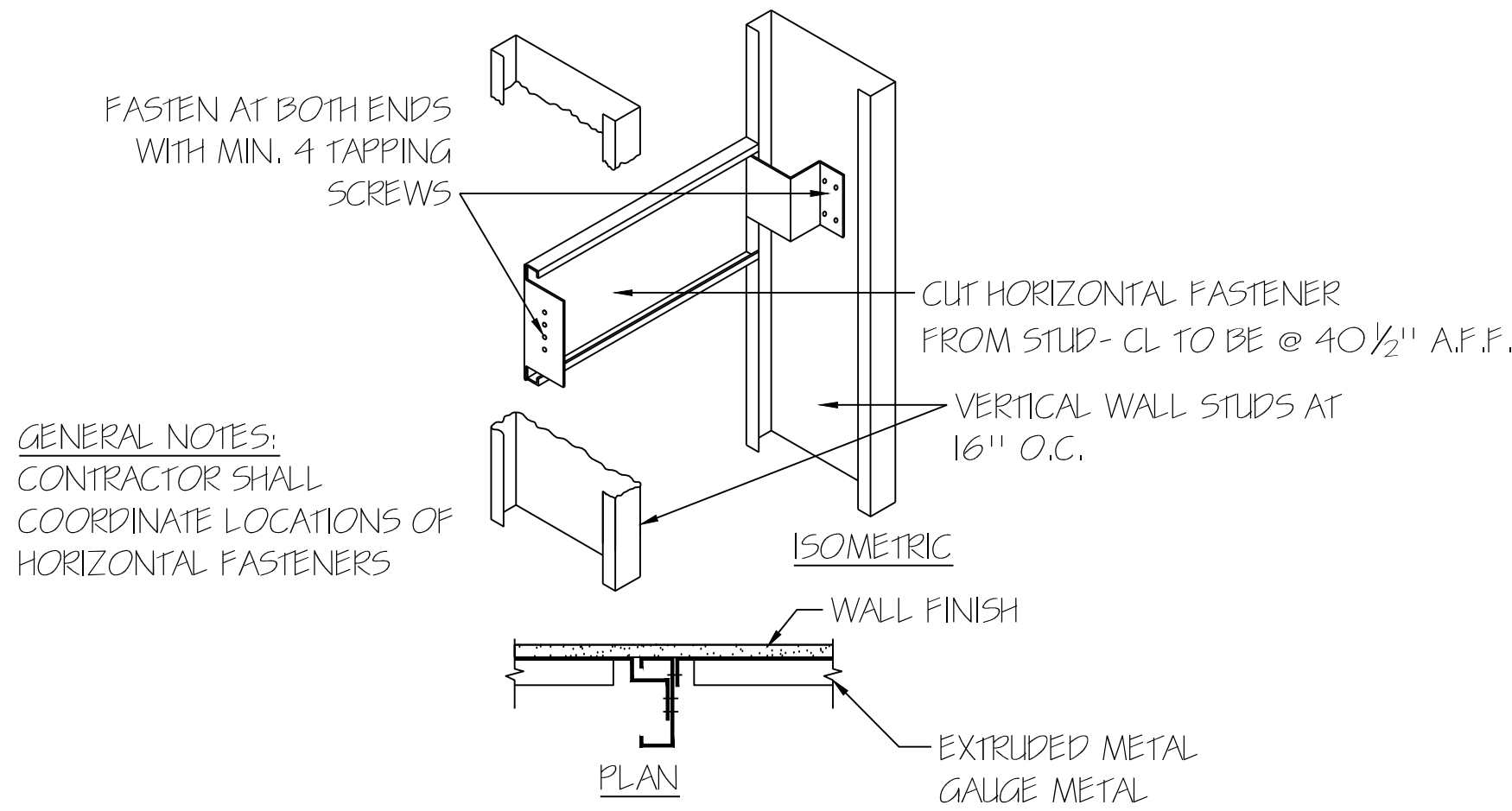


DUST PARTITIONS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED OF 2x4 STUDS AND 5/8" GYPSUM BOARD. PAINT ALL EXPOSED SIDE OF THE PARTITION WHITE. THE PARTITION SHALL BE SECURED TO AND SEALED TO ADJACENT SURFACES WITH POLYETHYLENE AND TAPE AS REQUIRED FOR A COMPLETE SEAL. PROVIDE EACH DUST PARTITION WITH A 3'-0" x 7'-0" DOOR THAT IS EQUIPPED WITH SELF CLOSING HINGES AND A HASP. THE DOOR SHALL BE SECURED WITH A VA PROVIDED PADLOCK. EACH DUST PARTITION SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH A CONTRACTOR FURNISHED FIRE EXTINGUISHER. THE SIZE OF EACH DUST PARTITION SHALL VARY AS REQUIRED TO MEET THE NEEDS OF EACH PROJECT. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALL DUST PARTITIONS WITH THE COR PRIOR TO INSTALLING PARTITION.

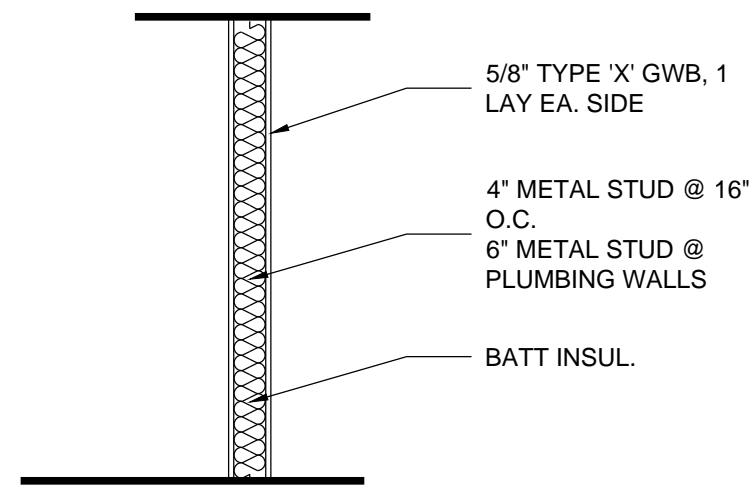
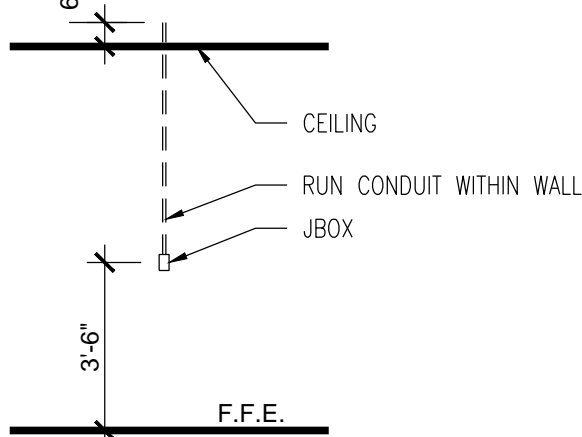
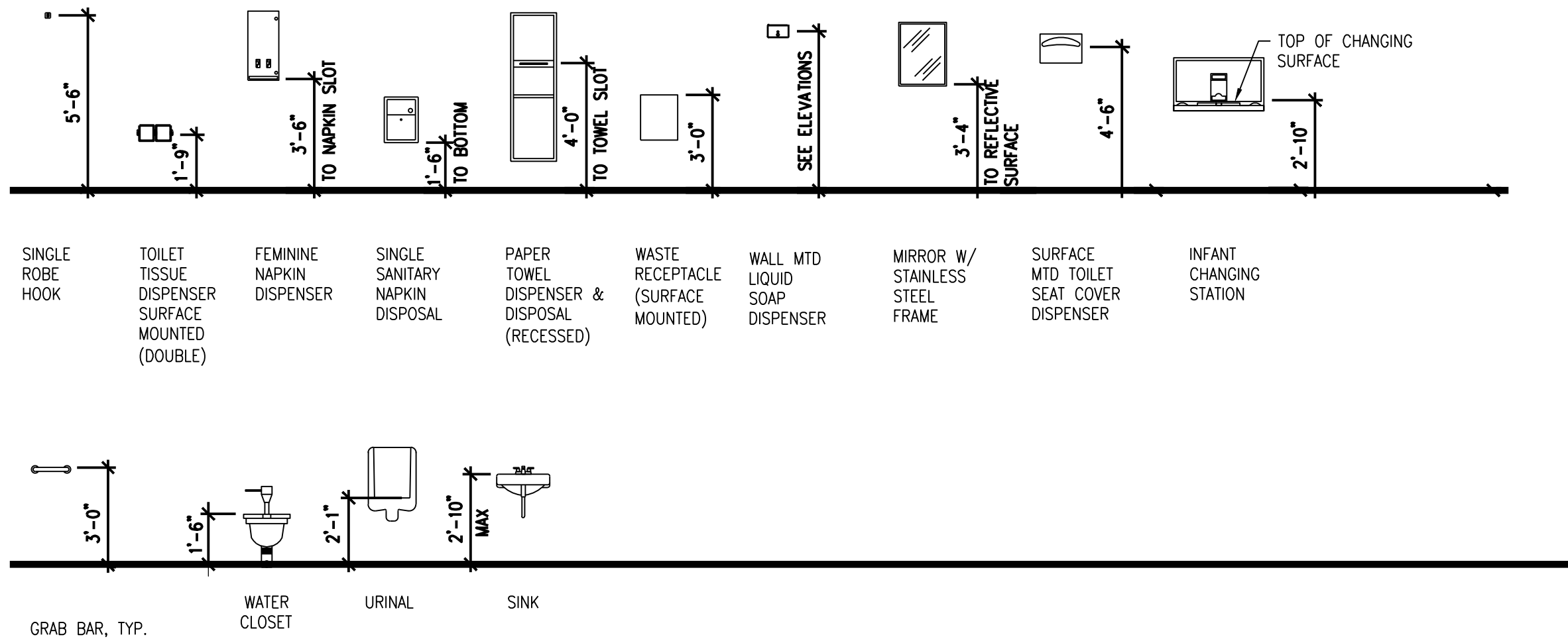


DUST PARTITIONS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED OF 2x4 METAL STUDS AND 5/8" GYPSUM BOARD. PAINT ALL EXPOSED SIDE OF THE PARTITION WHITE. THE PARTITION SHALL BE SECURED TO AND SEALED TO ADJACENT SURFACES WITH POLYETHYLENE AND TAPE AS REQUIRED FOR A COMPLETE SEAL. PROVIDE EACH DUST PARTITION WITH A 3'-0" x 7'-0" DOOR THAT IS EQUIPPED WITH SELF CLOSING HINGES AND A HASP. THE DOOR SHALL BE SECURED WITH A VA PROVIDED PADLOCK. EACH DUST PARTITION SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH A CONTRACTOR FURNISHED FIRE EXTINGUISHER. THE SIZE OF EACH DUST PARTITION SHALL VARY AS REQUIRED TO MEET THE NEEDS OF EACH PROJECT. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF ALL DUST PARTITIONS WITH THE COR PRIOR TO INSTALLING PARTITION.

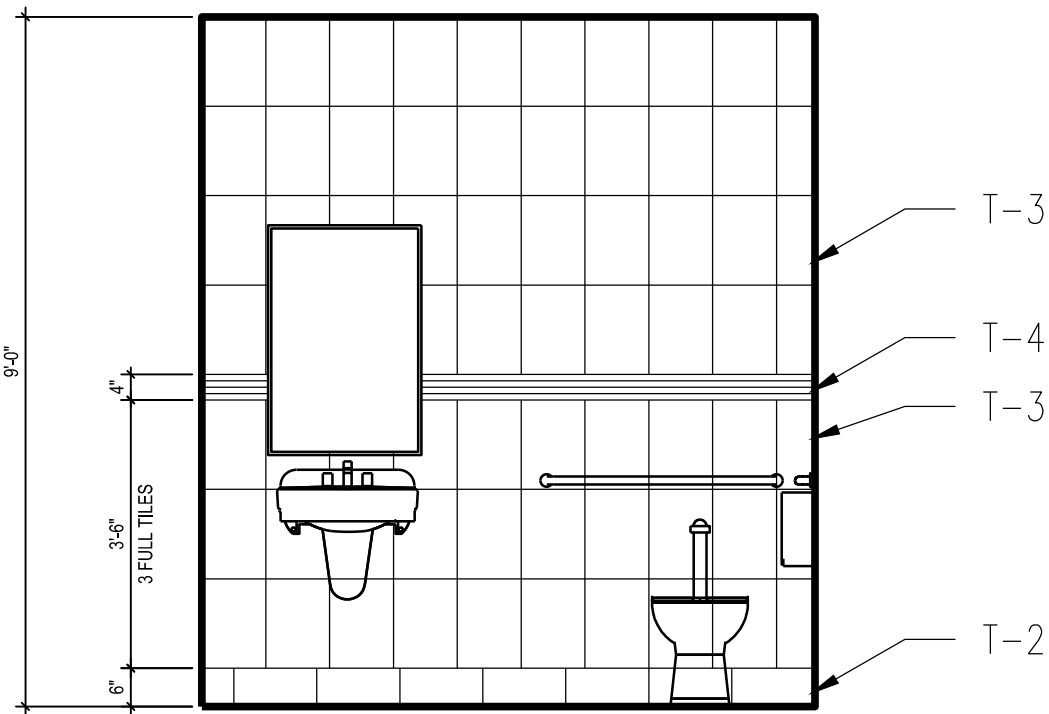

13. CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE DUST BARRIER FOR PROTECTION OF EXISTING AREAS TO REMAIN AS REQUIRED.
14. WHEN DEMOLITION TAKES PLACE, SHOULD ANY WORK AFFECT THE INTEGRITY OF THE STRUCTURE, WORK MUST STOP IMMEDIATELY, AND VA NOTIFIED UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL REINFORCING OF ANY KIND BE DAMAGED, CUT OR BROKEN.
15. REMOVE ALL WALL CONDUITS LEFT AFTER WALL DEMOLITION INCLUDING SWITCH BOXES, PLATES, BRIDGES, PLUMBING LINES, OR ANY OTHER TELEPHONE OR ELECTRICAL WIRING AND EQUIPMENT. DEMOLISHED LINES ARE TO BE BROUGHT BACK TO PANELS, RISERS, ETC. AND DISCONNECTED OR CAPPED.
16. CONTRACTOR TO REVIEW WITH VA REGARDING ALL ITEMS SCHEDULED FOR RELOCATION. SAID ITEMS TO BE REMOVED CAREFULLY, PROTECTED AND STORED.
17. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DEMOLITION OF EXISTING PARTITIONS, MOLDINGS, BASES (RUBBER, VINYL, METAL, CONCRETE, ETC.), SUSPENDED CEILINGS, LIGHT FIXTURES, SWITCHES, DOORS AND BUCKS, HARDWARE, ETC., AND ALL OTHER ITEMS REQUIRED TO BE DEMOLISHED TO ACCOMMODATE THE SCOPE OF WORK FOR NEW CONSTRUCTION.
18. EXISTING SPRINKLERS TO BE RELOCATED AS REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH NFPA.

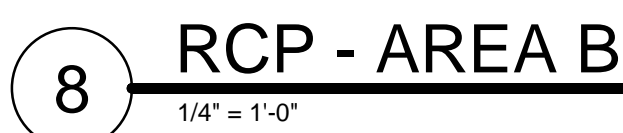

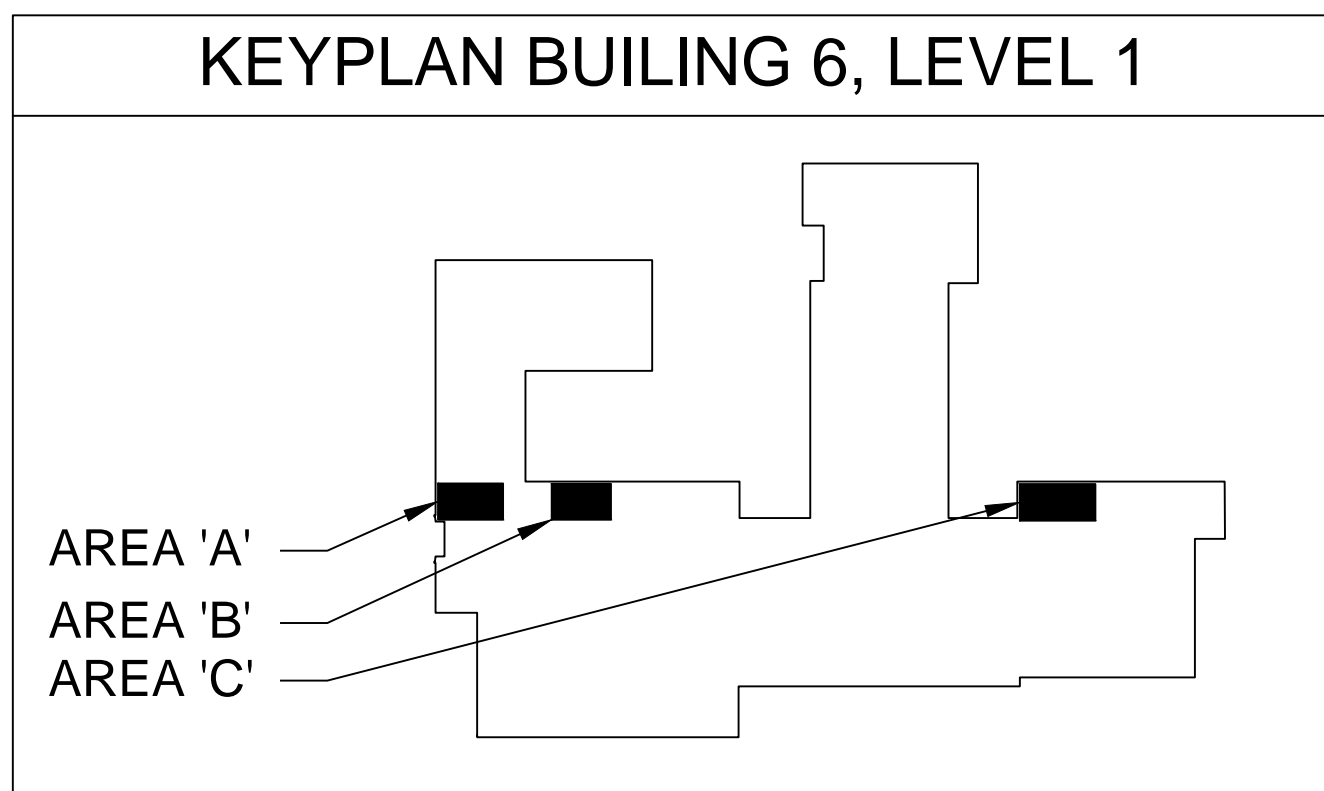
