Testing has been approved by CPRS 2/26/14. Testing is needed for the identification and treatment of non-small cell lung cancer (NSCLC). Abbott Molecular Vysis kits are to only test kits approved by the FDA for this type of NSCLC testing. See attachment for more details. Testing is required by national guidelines.

(3) (a) A DESCRIPTION OF THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES REQUIRED TO MEET THE AGENCY'S NEED:

All required items for testing are on FSS contract #V797D-40222, which expires August 31, 2019. These items are as follows: Vysis ALK Break Apart FISH Probe Kit (\$3169.01 each), Vysis Paraffin Pretreatment IV & Post Hyb Wash Buffer Kit (\$860 each), Vysis Probechek ALK Negative Control Slides Kit (\$301 each), and Vysis Probechek ALK Positive Control Slides Kit (\$301 each). This is a manual test that does not require any specialized equipment.

The items required for this test are: Vysis ALK Break Apart FISH Probe Kit, Vysis Paraffin Pretreatment IV & Post Hyb Wash Buffer Kit, Vysis Probechek ALK Negative Control Slides Kit, and Vysis Probechek ALK Positive Control Slides Kit. This is a manual test that does not require any specialized equipment.

A patent, copyright or proprietary data limits competition. The proprietary data is: <u>FDA approval. Abbott Laboratories is the sole known manufacturer and distributor of the Vysis ALK testing kits.</u> <u>The FDA has only approved this test by Abbott Laboratories; no similar tests were found.</u>

These are <u>"direct replacements" parts/components</u> for existing equipment.

The material/service must be compatible in all aspects (form, fit and function) with existing systems presently installed/performing. Describe the equipment/function you have now and how the new item/service must coordinate, connect, or interface with the existing system.

The new work is a logical follow-on to an original Federal Supply Schedule order provided that the original order was placed in accordance with the applicable Federal Supply Schedule ordering procedures. The original order must not have been previously issued under sole source or limited source procedures.

An urgent and compelling need exists, and following the ordering procedures would result in unacceptable delays.

Test kits are needed urgently to provide testing for current patients at the VA Western New York Healthcare System (VAWNYHCS). There are currently a couple of patients waiting for this test at the VAWNYHCS. This test is the only FDA approved test of its type for the identification of NSCLC and has just received approval for use from CPRS on 2/26/14. Abbott Molecular Vysis kits are to only test kits approved by the FDA for this type of NSCLC testing. See attachment for more details. Testing is required by national guidelines.

(5) DESCRIBE WHY YOU BELIEVE THE ORDER REPRESENTS THE BEST VALUE CONSISTENT WITH FAR <u>8.404</u>(d) TO AID THE CONTRACTING OFFICER IN MAKING THIS BEST VALUE DETERMINATION:

This test is now available on FSS contract. This test is the only FDA approved test of its type for the identification of NSCLC and has just received approval for use by VA laboratories from CPRS on 2/26/14. In the past, the laboratory utilized send out services for patients requiring this type of test. These send out services take more

time to complete due to the transfer of specimens from one site to another and the delay in receiving/processing the results. Further, the send out test is more costly than completing the test in house. Moreover, Abbott Laboratories, Inc. has a strong history of positive past performance. There are currently no terminations listed in the FAPIIS database and no recorded instances of defective pricing. Additionally, Abbott Laboratories delivery system is highly efficient and therefore is able to provide the supplies for this manual test quickly; this company is able to provide the testing materials to the facility within 2 days of receiving the order for the materials. Finally, when negotiated, the Contracting Officer for the FSS contract sought the best value for these tests. In addition to this, the Contracting Officer for this requirement will seek additional discounts if possible for this requirement.

(6) DESCRIBE THE MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AMONG SCHEDULE HOLDERS AND THE RESULTS OR A STATEMENT OF THE REASON MARKET RESEARCH WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

This is the only test of its type approved by the FDA for the identification of NSCLC. See attachment showing FDA approval for this test from Abbott. Additional searches were conducted to see if another company providing this test could be identified on GSA Advantage and on Google. No other company was identified as having this manual test.
