1. Title of Project: TABLETOP - Unit Dose Packaging System for Oral Solids – Huntsville Annex
2. Scope of Work: The Birmingham VA Medical Center needs one (1) TABLETOP - Unit Dose Packaging System for Oral Solids streamlining the packaging process for oral solids by aiding in the efficiency in which tablets and capsules are packaged into unit dose.

Specifically, we require the following:

Auto-Print 2" Unit Dose Packing System for Oral Solids with an Auto-Print Oral Solid Feeder, a variable package length option, a CF-1 Custom Feeder and a 2D USB Barcode Scanner.

Bids must include installation and training.

Bids must also include, AT NO COST TO THE GOVERNMENT, a one-year warrantee and product-life technical support, as needed, to include on-site, telephonic and/or on-line as agreed upon at the time by the VA and the contractor.

Freight must be included in bids.

Delivery must be made to the Birmingham VA Medical Center Annex located at 500 Markaview Road NW, Huntsville, AL 35805 between 15 March 2015 and 15 May 2015.

Successful bidder will be required to attend an on-site pre-installation and safety meeting prior to installation.
