### **REQUEST:**

It is respectfully noted, within the RFP there is a statement: Contractors working on federal construction projects shall be licensed in the State of West Virginia.

Please advise if this refers to a business license and/or additional licenses.

### **GOVERNMENT RESPONSE:**

The contractor license is not just a business license. Contractors working on federal construction projects must, without additional expense to the Government, be responsible for obtaining any necessary licenses and permits and for complying with any Federal, State, municipal laws, codes, regulations applicable to the performance of the work. Therefore, since the State of WV requires all contractors operating in the State of WV to meet certain licensing requirements, then these laws and regulations apply even to contractors working on federal construction projects. See FAR 32.236-7 and State law (Chapter 21, Article 11 of State Code).
