PARAGRAPH 8. BID CONTENTS IS REVISED. REVISIONS ARE IN BOLD BELOW:

8. BID CONTENTS:

- a. Standard Form (SF) 1442 - (Box 14-20 completed and signed acknowledging all amendments; do not fill in anything in "Award" section, from box 21 down).
- b. Bid/Price Schedule – Base Bid, Bid Deductive Alternates #2, #3, and #4 – attached to Solicitation No. VA262-15-R-0027. Bidders shall bid on all items. Bids shall be submitted on the Bid Price Schedule Form contained in the solicitation.
- c. Bid Guarantee/Bonds - (SF24). Bid Guarantee - On Standard Form 24. The surety must be on the Department of Treasury Approved Sureties List. Submission of original hard copy with wet signature is required.
- d. General Contractor's License - All Bidders shall submit a current Copy of General Contractor's License from the SDVOSB Prime.

PARAGRAPH "e." BELOW IS DELETED IN ITS ENTIRETY, NOT REQUIRED TO SUBMIT WITH BID:

~~e. FAR Part 52.219-28 Post-Award Small Business Program Representation – All Bidders shall fill-out, sign certification and submit with all bids.~~

- f. FAR Part 52.209-5 Representation By Corporations Regarding an Unpaid Tax Liability or a Felony Conviction Under Any Federal Law (Deviation) (March 2012) – All Bidders shall fill-out and include FAR Part 209-5 with their Bid. See page 40.

PARAGRAPH "g." IS REVISED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING THE EXPERIENCE MODIFICATION RATE (EMR):

- g. Safety or Environmental violations and Experience Modification Rate (EMR) - All Bidders shall include with their Bid, past Safety and Environment record and current EMR. See paragraph 22.

Please note that EMR shall be provided from the following sources below:

- All Bidders shall submit information regarding their current EMR equal to or less than 1.0. This information shall be obtained from the bidder's insurance company and be furnished on the insurance carrier's letterhead.

- All Self-insured Contractors or other Contractors that cannot provide their EMR rating on insurance letterhead must obtain a rating from the National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (NCCI) by completing/submitting form EMR-6 and providing the rating on letterhead from NCCI. Note: Self-insured Contractors or other Contractors that cannot provide EMR rating on insurance letterhead from the states or territories of CA, DE, MI, NJ, ND, OH, PA, WA, WY, and PR shall obtain their EMR rating from their state run worker's compensation insurance rating bureau.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS INCORPORATED BELOW:

- All bidders who are not qualified or not eligible or not able to submit an EMR rating; shall submit an EMR rating from the following:
 1. National Council on Compensation Insurance, Inc. (NCCI) letterhead;
 2. Or bidder state run worker's compensation insurance rating bureau letterhead;
 3. Or from bidder insurance carrier's letterhead explaining why the bidder is not eligible or not qualified for an EMR rating.
