

## B.2 LIMITATIONS ON SUBCONTRACTING-- MONITORING AND COMPLIANCE (JUN 2011)

This solicitation includes VAAR 852.219-10 VA Notice of Total Service- Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business Set-Aside. Accordingly, any contract resulting from this solicitation will include this clause. The contractor is advised in performing contract administration functions, the CO may use the services of a support contractor(s) retained by VA to assist in assessing the contractor's compliance with the limitations on subcontracting or percentage of work performance requirements specified in the clause. To that end, the support contractor(s) may require access to contractor's offices where the contractor's business records or other proprietary data are retained and to review such business records regarding the contractor's compliance with this requirement. All support contractors conducting this review on behalf of VA will be required to sign an "Information Protection and Non-Disclosure and Disclosure of Conflicts of Interest Agreement" to ensure the contractor's business records or other proprietary data reviewed or obtained in the course of assisting the CO in assessing the contractor for compliance are protected to ensure information or data is not improperly disclosed or other impropriety occurs. Furthermore, if VA determines any services the support contractor(s) will perform in assessing compliance are advisory and assistance services as defined in FAR 2.101, Definitions, the support contractor(s) must also enter into an agreement with the contractor to protect proprietary information as required by FAR 9.505-4, obtaining access to proprietary information, paragraph (b). The contractor is required to cooperate fully and make available any records as may be required to enable the CO to assess the contractor's compliance with the limitations on subcontracting or percentage of work performance requirement.

### STATEMENT OF WORK

#### FIRE PUMP REPLACEMENT

##### 1.1 GENERAL INTENTION

- A. Vendor shall furnish labor, materials, equipment and supervision for the replacement of one (1) [Patterson serial number: FAAL011F0012346](#) fire pump, (1) [Burks serial number: 400395 jokey pump](#) and [Firetrol catalog number: FTA1300-AA30B and FTA950-BA100B](#) controller in the subbasement (Room SD105) of the Birmingham VAMC. Vendor is responsible for the removal of existing unit and replacement of all associated components.
- B. Visits to the site by Bidders may be made only by appointment with Engineering Department (138) at 205/933-4481.
- C. All employees of vendor shall comply with VA security management program and obtain permission of the VA police, be identified by project and employer, and restricted from unauthorized access.

## 1.2 STATEMENT OF NEED

- A. ITEM I, Replace Fire Pump: Work includes installation of new fire pump, [jokey pump](#) and controller in the subbasement (Room SD105) of the Birmingham VAMC. Work includes the removal of existing fire pump. Additionally, the work includes the reconnection to the fire sprinkler system piping and any associated components in order to ensure proper function of the replacement fire pump. Includes required testing and certification. Period of Performance - requirement shall be completed 30 days from date of award.

## 1.3 SECURITY REQUIREMENTS

### A. Security Procedures:

1. Vendor employees shall not enter the project site without appropriate badge. They may also be subject to inspection of their personal effects when entering or leaving the project site.
2. For working outside the "regular hours" as defined in the contract, the Vendor shall give 3 days notice to the Contracting Officer so that security escort arrangements can be provided for the employees.
3. No photography of VA premises is allowed without written permission of the Contracting Officer.
4. VA reserves the right to close down or shut down the project site and order Vendor's employees off the premises in the event of a national emergency. The Vendor may return to the site only with the written approval of the Contracting Officer.

## 1.4 OPERATIONS AND STORAGE AREAS

- A. The Vendor shall confine all operations (including storage of materials) on Government premises to areas authorized or approved by the Contracting Officer. The Vendor shall hold and save the Government, its officers and agents, free and harmless from liability of any nature occasioned by the Vendor's performance.

## 1.5 INFECTION PREVENTION MEASURES

- A. Implement the requirements of VAMC's Infection Control Risk Assessment (ICRA) team. ICRA Group may monitor dust in the vicinity of the installation work and require the Vendor to take corrective action immediately if the safe levels are exceeded.
