Amendment issued to answer questions from prospective vendors.

Q.1. "Is the Cemetery going to continue to be in control of the fertilization of the turf? There is currently no adjustment to the amount of fertilizer applied. i.e. fertilizer was applied in early June this year. With all the heavy rainfall, no fertilizer was needed and the contractor has to deal with the excess clippings."

A.1. Fertilizer services are currently provided under a separate contract.

Q.2. "Will the contractor be compensated for excessive growth? If 2 cuts per week are needed to stay in compliance, will the contractor be paid for 2 cuts per week?"

A.2. Contract has extra cut built in however all extra cuts MUST be approved by the COR prior to the work being done.

Q.3 "Do the flat markers need to be edged every mowing?"

A.3. The flat markers should be edged each cycle unless disallowed by the COR.

Q.4. "Can you explain "remove all foreign material" from the artificial turf under CLIN 0006 ? Are the areas to be simply blown off to remove leaves, or is it to be completely free of any material, no matter how small?"

A.4. Foreign material is anything that isn't supposed to be on the artificial turf e.g. leaves, limbs, trash, etc.,.

Q.5. "Under CLIN 0005 floral and debris removal, are there any other specifications? Currently the cemetery requires that any handmade, expensive or unique arrangements are saved, marked as to which gravesite they came from, and set aside. Is this still a requirement?"

A.5. It is the practice of the Government to attempt to save what may be important items found during floral removal, these will be marked with the section and gravesite and set aside for the COR to retrieve.

Q.6. "Also under flower pickup, Jefferson Barracks requires the contractor to save flowers vases. The flowers are removed from the vases and separated. Vases are saved by the cemetery for future use. This is time consuming and I see no current specifications to do this. Will this be required under this contract?"

A.6. The Government will continue to save usable vases for future use. Reusable vases will be removed from the floral arrangement and placed in a Government supplied container located in the area of the floral dumpster.

Q.7. "Under the flower CLIN, it states the COR will give instructions. Will the contractor be compensated for items that require more labor such as separating vases, marking arrangements, etc.?"

A.7. No, the contractor should bid according to what the cemetery requires.

Q.8. "What is the timeframe for picking up flowers? None is specified in the SOW."

A.8. Flower pick up will be scheduled by the Cemetery Director, floral pick up will commence on the scheduled start date and be completed no later than the end of that mowing cycle.

Q.9. "Currently areas that have an irrigation system are watered daily. This is more water than needed or recommended by standard practices. Will this continue?"

A.9. This question is based on an inaccurate premise. The system is set up for much reduced watering on the night before the scheduled mowing. However, if an area is still too damp to mow, these areas will be mowed later in the day.

Q.10. “Areas that are watered are currently wet every morning, making it difficult to mow without leaving grass clumps. Will this be adjusted?”

A.10. It has been adjusted.
