- Contractor is not directed how to perform
- Contractor is directed on performance required per final PWS

Single Award. Supply, delivery and installation

CLIN Structure:

- Firm Fixed Price for Supplies and Installation

PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

- General Offer completed and signed as well as amendments
- Section B completed
- Hard copies: 1 Original and one copy
- Electronic copies: 1 copy
- Pricing Proposal Supports Technical Proposals
- Pricing Proposal must be separate from Technical Proposal

EVALUATION

- Best Value Trade-Offs. Government may award to other than the lowest priced quoter or other than the highest technically rated offeror.

- Four Non-Price Evaluation Criteria: 1) Technical/Management Approach; 2) Schedule; 3) Past Performance of the Prime; 4) Participation of Small Business In The Performance of This Contract

- Price
 - Not evaluated or rated
 - Provide pricing for Supply, Delivery and Installation

PPIRS

Past performance will be evaluated using the Past Performance Information Retrieval System (PPIRS) for performance records on government contracts. PPIRS will supersede any Past Performance Questionnaires.

Please review the [PPIRS Site](#) for any relevant past performance history available for your DUNS number. PPIRS provides federal government past performance reports completed through CPARS.

If relevant past performance history is available for your DUNS number, provide a list of comparable contract numbers listed in PPIRS.

For non-government contracts, please utilize the Past Performance Questionnaire process.

A lack of past performance information will result in a neutral rating during evaluations.

INVOICING

- Contractor may submit invoices once delivery and installation is completed and accepted by COR.
- See VAAR Clause 852.232-72, Electronic Submission of Payment Requests for invoicing procedures.
- Each CLIN will provide the unit measure for payment, i.e monthly, each or job. Please note if states per job, invoicing is only allowed after job is completed. As such, awareness to time for completion of job is crucial.
- Invoicing must match unit of measure, quantity and description of CLINs
- All Invoices must contain the Obligation # provided on award document.

SITE VISIT WALK THROUGH

- When you are onsite, you are not allowed to take pictures.

- Measurements may be taken
