Proposal RFI #1 – Specification Section 01 45 29, Part 1.1 states the Testing Laboratory will be retained by the VA. Revised Section 01 00 00 (issued in Amendment A00001), Part 1.1 – D states that the Testing Laboratory will be retained by the Contractor. Please clarify whether the Testing Laboratory will be retained by the VA or by the Contractor.

As stated in revised Section 01 00 00 (issued in Amendment A00001), Part 1.1, all Testing Laboratories shall be retained by the Contractor.

Proposal RFI #2 – Revised Section 01 00 00 Part 1.31 – Photographic Documentation requires the Contractor to hire a professional commercial photographer to photographically document the progress for this project. Since this is a large expense that will be added to the Contractor's offer, please confirm that a professional photographer will be required for this project.

A professional photographer that meets the requirements described in Revised Section 01 00 00 is required for this project. If no project progress is scheduled, weekly photos are not needed in those weeks.
