(2) NATURE AND/OR DESCRIPTION OF ACTION BEING APPROVED:

This justification for other than full and open competition is prepared by the Department of Veterans Affairs Network Contracting Office 6 (NCO 6) on behalf of the Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Richmond, VA. The requirement is for an InTouch Partnership Agreement for the repair of Toshiba Aquilion 64 and Ailion One CT Scan equipment. A firm fixed price purchase order will be awarded on a sole source basis to Toshiba America Medical Systems with a period of performance of 10/1/2015 through 9/30/2016.

(3) (a) A DESCRIPTION OF THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES REQUIRED TO MEET THE AGENCY'S NEED:

One (1) year maintenance agreement supporting CT Scan equipment with serial numbers SID# [REDACTED] and SID# [REDACTED].

This request is for the service/support of current software/equipment used at the Hunter Holmes McGuire VAMC Radiology Department. Toshiba America Medical is the only responsible source with regard to the service and maintenance of the Aquilion 64 CT system. Toshiba America Medical does not train third party service companies, nor does it provide documentation, schematics or diagnostic software to third party vendors. The VA Veterans Health Administration has a procurement policy that prohibits the use of "gray market" items in VHA facilities. Gray market items include second sourced parts and remanufactured items in distribution channels unintended by the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM). The Defense Supply Center Philadelphia, in coordination with the VA VHA, administers a mandatory source contract for the maintenance of "High Tech Medical Equipment (HTME)". Under this program, Toshiba America Medical Systems was awarded contract number SPM2D1-09-D-8322/V797P-6033(b), which includes maintenance support for the Aquilion CT scan equipment. The Veterans Affairs Office of Acquisition and Logistics issued a delegation of authority for the procurement of the required services, on the HTME contract, with delegation number V797P-6033B-V044.

(5) DESCRIBE WHY YOU BELIEVE THE ORDER REPRESENTS THE BEST VALUE CONSISTENT WITH FAR 8.4 TO AID THE CONTRACTING OFFICER IN MAKING THIS BEST VALUE DETERMINATION:

HTME contract number SPM2D1-09-D-8322/V797P-6033(b) was negotiated prior to award by the National Acquisition Center and the Defense Logistics Agency. Orders against the contract represent the best value to the Government due to pre-negotiated pricing and reduced administrative costs.

(6) DESCRIBE THE MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AMONG SCHEDULE HOLDERS AND THE RESULTS OR A STATEMENT OF THE REASON MARKET RESEARCH WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

A sources sought was made available on FBO.gov on 8 July 2015. Six (6) responses were received and did not indicate any alternatives to a sole source award to Toshiba. Toshiba provided a response indicating that the AQ 64 CT scan equipment contains proprietary software and components, as well as a proprietary CT tube. The remaining five (5) responses were received from companies who were either not capable or not interested. The mandatory source vehicle awarded under the HTME program was subsequently identified.

There are no additional facts to support the justification.
