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Amendment issued to address the following questions from prospective vendors:

Q.1.: The system is currently off. Can we proceed with the replacement with the system off?

A.1.: Yes.

Q.2.: With the system off presently (most likely for leaks), if there is a leak in any of the existing branch lines/sprinkler pipe, who is responsible for fixing those if they leak?

A.1.: The contractor would be responsible for any new leaks and/or damage to the system while it is being worked on under this contract (52.236-9 Protection of Existing Vegetation, Structures, Equipment, Utilities, and Improvements).

Q.3.: In the mezzanine mechanical room, are there asbestos items, and is there a certificate available that things are ok?

A.1.: There are no known asbestos items located in the mechanical room.

A.2.: There is not a certificate.

Q.4.: Could you give us the hydrant water flow information from the hydrant nearest the building?

A.1.: 60-80 PSI

Q.5.: In the spec, you want the new main to run in the main drive lane area and not above the locker rooms. If we are to re-pipe the main this way, how do we back feed the existing branch lines? The larger pipe is fed from the opposite side reducing toward the main drive lane.

A.1: Yes, connect to the smaller end, the hydraulics will still work.

Q.6.: The existing mechanical tees that feed the branch lines from the existing main utilize a gasket. Are we to re-attached these mechanical tees, do we supply new, or is there a separate welded/threaded outlet we need to use?

A.1.: Use threaded welded outlets.
