**(2) NATURE AND/OR DESCRIPTION OF ACTION BEING APPROVED:**

This contract is for maintenance and service to the Operating Room and Animal Research Facility chiller equipment as outlined in the scope of work. This equipment was previously covered by the Main Chiller plant contract VA528-15-F-0017 which expired on September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015. This requirement for a firm fixed price contract, period of performance is from 1/1/2016 to 12/31/2016 with 4 one year options.

**(3) (a) A DESCRIPTION OF THE SUPPLIES OR SERVICES REQUIRED TO MEET THE AGENCY'S NEED:**

Services needed are to operate, maintain and repair the chiller equipment and proprietary automation systems in the operating theater of the hospital. The IGCE estimated this annual contract to be roughly \$80,000.00 annually with a base contract from 1/1/2016 to 12/31/2016 plus four 1-year follow on contract options. Services to be performed are outlined in the scope of work and include but not limited to weekly, monthly, and semi-annual system checks and preventive maintenance to the chiller plant equipment.

The main central chiller plant AND the OR/ARF Chillers were part of 1 contract prior to separating the 2 in 2015. Trane Tracer Summit was the single propriatary control system to operate all chillers and equipment. When soliciting for the chiller plant maintenance contract in 2006 there were two other vendors, beside Trane Inc., interested, but they both failed to meet the requirements. Johnson Controls Inc. and Carrier Inc. both conducted the walkthrough of the facility but did not bid on the service agreement due to the proprietary rights of software programming. Again in 2010 the solicitation outlined "contractor requirements", specifically service personnel with requirements to be OEM manufacturer factory trained. No vendor was found capable of providing a qualified offer. VISN 2 published a Sources Sought Notice to FedBizOps (FBO) was issued on Nov 7, 2014, with solicitation number of VA58-15-Q-0024. This synopsis identified the background and technical requirements for the chiller plant maintenance needed for the Albany VA. It provided a list of requirements and the anticipated verification method/documentation to ensure that any potential sources could meet the described requirements. The response due date was Nov 14, 2014 and did not successfully facilitate competition. Further, VISN 2 Published an EBUY RFI Sources Sought on August 26, 2015 closing on August 31, 2015 - only one response was generated. It was decided that Sole Source Acquisition was warranted.

**(5) DESCRIBE WHY YOU BELIEVE THE ORDER REPRESENTS THE BEST VALUE CONSISTENT WITH FAR 8.4 TO AID THE CONTRACTING OFFICER IN MAKING THIS BEST VALUE DETERMINATION:**

Trane pricing is based on their current GSA Federal Supply Schedule (FSS) contract, GS-06F-0079R, (<http://www.gsaweblink.com/FACServices/>) and all its associated terms, conditions and negotiated pricing.

**(6) DESCRIBE THE MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AMONG SCHEDULE HOLDERS AND THE RESULTS OR A STATEMENT OF THE REASON MARKET RESEARCH WAS NOT CONDUCTED:**

An examination of the acquisition history and experience with the marketplace for similar acquisitions yielded proprietary rights for system software are consistent across the industry. There are similar instances with other HVAC Controls vendors such as Johnson Controls, Carrier, and Honeywell. A search of the Small Business Administration (SBA) Dynamic Small Business Search System identified no SDVOSB, VOSB, Woman Owned Small Businesses (WOSB), Small Businesses (SB), 8(a), and Hubzones when searching using keywords "Trane" or NAICS 238220. A search of the Vetbiz website was also conducted using the same search criteria without success. As described in Section 6 above, market research was conducted by sources sought for the proposed acquisition, advising industry of the pending acquisition and soliciting inquiries from interested parties. This also yielded only one result identifying the Proprietary contractor as a source.

**(7) ANY OTHER FACTS SUPPORTING THE JUSTIFICATION:**

Trane Tracer Summit control system was installed prior to 2001 for the OR and ARF Chiller controls. Albany has invested a significant amount of capital to maintain consistency and reliability with HVAC controls and its central ARF/OR Chiller Plant. The facility has undergone a major upgrade to the Main Chiller Plant where TRANE was awarded a full maintenance contract. The OR/ARF Chillers were once part of the main chiller contract due to the control systems operating as one. Since the upgrades the main chiller plant was separated out from the control systems.

The Stratton VA Medical Center has invested significant capital to provide automation and services that greatly increase energy efficiency, reliable operations, and comfort for patients, employees, and visitors. Potentially, a significant capital investment would ensue to remove barriers to open competition for HVAC and Chiller Equipment controls. Additionally, if barriers were removed to allow open competition there would remain another vendor contract for the operations, maintenance and service to their systems is a packaged one-time procurement and installation of hardware and proprietary software. The supporting services throughout the base and option years are linked directly with the initial hardware and software purchase.
