

**ATTACHMENT NO. THREE
TASK AND FREQUENCY CHART
INTEGRATED RODENT AND PEST MANAGEMENT PROGRAM
AT VAMC CANANDAIGUA**

1. Monthly Service:
 - a. Buildings 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, Laundry, Warehouse, 16, 33 and 118.
 - b. Routine service to be provided every first and third Wednesday of the month with the buildings listed above to be divided between each Wednesday.
 - c. Check with SPD Chief in the Basement of Building 34 to see if they are having any pest control issues.
2. Quarterly Service: Includes moth control.
 - a. Personnel Quarters – Buildings 14, 20.
 - b. Clothing Rooms – Building 33.
 - c. Pavilion, Court 1.
 - d. Quarterly service to be provided in the second month of each quarter (November, February, May and August).
3. Non-Routine Services:
 - a. Service to be provided to all Medical Center grounds including but not limited to: corridors (tunnels), Buildings 12, 16, 40 and Courts 1 and 2, 37 A & B, 34 A & B, 36 A & B.
 - b. Service to be provided bi-monthly for residual treatment of all facility trash huts, loading dock and soiled linen areas as necessary to control common flies and treatment in areas as appropriate for the control of cluster flies during the months of May through September.
 - c. Annual Cluster Fly Spraying done at the end of the summer. Please include as separate line item on bid.
4. Dietetic Areas: Monthly Service and Callback
 - a. Date of Service – Areas are to be serviced on the first Wednesday of each month.
 - b. Times of Service – Service to begin approximately 7:00 P.M. Callback visits to begin approximately 7:00 P.M.
 - c. Guide – Environmental Management Service or designated Nutrition and Food Service employees will accompany the Contractor during his/her Nutrition and Food Service visits.
 - d. Areas – Including but not limited to: Dining areas, meat shop and bake shop and all storage areas.
5. Vending Areas: Building 2 and Building 36 – Monthly Service Callbacks
 - a. Date of service – Areas are to be serviced on the first Wednesday of the month.
 - b. Times of Service – Areas are to be serviced at approximately 6:00 P.M.
 - c. Guide – Environmental Management Service employee will accompany the contractor during his/her Vending Room visits.

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- d. The room will be vacated by all other personnel when the area is being treated
- e. Callbacks – To be serviced at approximately 6:00 P.M.

6. Canteen Areas: Monthly Service and Callback

- a. Date of Service – Areas are to be serviced on the first Wednesday of each month.
- b. Time and Sequence of Service – Building 4 Canteen Areas – Routine service to begin at approximately 4:30 P.M. and proceed in the following order: Retail Store, Stockroom, Barber shop, Cafeteria Kitchen and Cafeteria.
- c. Callbacks – To be serviced at approximately 4:30 P.M.

7. Treatments will be performed for the control of filter flies at the Sewage Treatment Plant and the grassy area within the fenced compound. Treatment may include, but is not limited to application of a residual pesticide on the exterior of the trickling filter containment vessel.

8. Cluster fly preventive maintenance will be performed in August. Preventive maintenance includes the spraying of the grounds, windows and overhangs surrounding buildings 1, 4, 33, 36 and 37.
