The purpose of this letter is to inform your firm that the subject request for proposal is hereby cancelled. NO award will be made from this solicitation and the proposal process is hereby terminated.

We regret having to take this action however this decision was necessary due to several converging factors, largely driven by changes to the scope of work, tasks and personnel that have occurred over the time we were conducting competition. The Department of Veterans Affairs is also facing shrinking budgets that impacted this decision.

WE are working with San Francisco VA Medical Center's Social Work Services to redraft the applicable documents to meet the changed need for this procurement.
