3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:

This contract involves the replacement of the CT tube, HV cables, calibration and test of the Sensation
64 Slice CT. The Sensation 64 Slice CT is the Saint Louis MO. VAMC's main CT used for the majority of CT
scans because of the additional capabilities and features. The estimated total cost is \$211,076.50.
