BIDS RECEIVED FROM PROSPECTIVE CONTRACTORS WHOM ARE NOT VERIFIED WILL BE CONSIDERED NON-RESPONSIVE AND THE BID WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR AWARD.

BIDDER QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS

1.1 QUESTION: Will this project take place on Government owned property?

ANSWER: YES.

1.2 QUESTION: Will a local Building Permit be required?

ANSWER: See FAR Clause 52.236-7, Permits and Responsibilities.

1.3 QUESTION: Will a State of California Contractor License be required or will any SDVOSB Contractor holding a valid Contractor's License in their state be permitted to submit an offer for this solicitation?

ANSWER: Per IFB instructions, current general contractor's license is required. Licenses are not restricted to the state of California general contractors.

2. QUESTION: Reference drawing SS605, it is not clear what the extent of the canopy is that is shown as AS-102. Also, detail 8 says see 1/SS605, there is no drawing for SS605, please advise.

ANSWER: Canopy is existing. See glass specification section 08 80 00.

3. QUESTION: Reference specification 09 06 00 and drawing 5/AE800, can you give more information on the GL-8 described on the schedule for finishes (spec 09 06 00 page 4). It's described as "clear laminated fully tempered glass; interlayer' silkscreen ceramic frit pattern, opaque frit, high opacity white". Is there a specific pattern, like 40% dot or to match the patter detailed on 5/AE800?

ANSWER: V1086 has "line" frit pattern. 40% coverage.

4. QUESTION: Deductive alternate No. 3 calls for deletion of the west wall composite panels. If they are deleted what is being substituted?

ANSWER: Waterproofing remains exposed. No additional material.

5. QUESTION: Can any elevations drawings for the restrooms that show how high you want the tiles to go be made available for pre-bid?

ANSWER: See sheet AE601 for reference of heights. Detail 1/AE601.
