(2) NATURE AND/OR DESCRIPTION OF ACTION BEING APPROVED:
Placing urgent request for a new Ophthalmology microscope as the current model in use has become inoperable during surgeries which have caused many surgeries to be cancelled as there is no replacement at this time. This is causing a delay in patient care as several Veterans have had to be cancelled. Trials were performed on other microscopes and the old model was fixed but continues to break each time during a surgical procedure.

Lumera 700 with magnetic clutches, XYcoupling, integrated beam splitter, with deselectable integrated assistant scope with motorized Zoom (selectable linked or independent assistant zoom) or alternatively manual magnification changer, Superlux Eye Xenon light source with integrated HaMode filter or halogen or LED light source, SCI-Stereo coaxial illumination, motorized zoom (range 1:6), motorized focus and fast focus functionality, depth of focus management system Deep View, binocular tubes, wide field eyepieces, apochromatic objective lens and asepsis with 5.7" GUI touchscreen, wireless or wired 14 function foot control panel.

[REDACTED] Our current microscope went down end of March/1st of April necessitating surgery cancellations for Wed 4/6/16. We were able to get the Zeiss microscope on trial enabling us to do the cases on Wed 4/7/16. It took a while for [REDACTED] to locate a microscope that we could trial but we wanted to ensure that we were fair and that we were making an informed decision in choosing the microscope. The view of the surgical field is critical to performing a safe operation; you have to be able to see what you're doing. The clarity of that view is dependent upon a combination of the lighting, magnification and focus features of the surgical microscope. The Zeiss microscope is superior in this regard. In most microscopes the assistant's view is dependent upon that of the main surgeon. However, in a teaching facility the supervising surgeon uses the assistant scope to oversee the case. The Zeiss scope has a unique feature giving the assistant fine focusing capabilities and the option to independently magnify the surgical view which is crucial for patient safety while teaching. Other scopes have neither or only one of these options. In the small and confined space of the eye, even small differences in image clarity can make a big difference in the surgical outcome. Cataract surgery is performed in a space that averages 12 mm wide by 3 mm deep and entails working around tissue that is 5-10 microns thick.
