

Scope of Work

Parking Lot C Expansion
VA Central California Health Care System

The project scope of work is: Contractor shall provide all labor, materials, tools, equipment, supervision and transportation as necessary for the scope described herein and as further defined by other documents included in this request for proposal (RFP). Work includes demolition of concrete curbing and minor asphalt pavement areas. Work also includes compaction and grading of areas to be paved or landscaped, asphalt patching of parking areas, parking lot striping, asphalt slurry coating, new concrete curbs and sidewalks, design and installation of sprinkler laterals/heads for new landscaping, turf and bark chip landscaping, bollards, signage, utility trench, one parking lot light standard, temporary traffic control plans and other items relative to this project. All work shall be completed at the Central California Healthcare System located at 2615 E. Clinton Ave. Fresno, CA 93703 per approved plans and specifications.

Work includes the following:

Saw Cuts: Saw cut existing asphalt surface to provide a clean straight edge along areas bordering the dirt lot.

Fees & Permits: All disposal fees shall be paid by the contractor. All permits and fees associated with traffic closures, air quality control, waste water management, and related tasks required to accomplish the scope of this project shall be attained and paid for by the contractor. An intermediate traffic plan will be required for review and approval for any impact to parking and vehicle and pedestrian access ways. Contractor shall provide alternate or temporary means of access as required.

Duration: To minimize impacts to the facility, the project duration is restricted to six weeks from the Notice to Proceed (NTP). This time frame is to include all necessary document submittals and approvals required by the project specifications.

Contract work hours: Normal work hours for the contract are from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM Monday through Friday, unless specifically noted otherwise. Contractor shall exclude from the normal work week the following listed holidays or the days observed in lieu thereof by the Department of Veterans Affairs:

New Years Day	Presidents' Day
Martin Luther King's Birthday	Memorial Day
Independence Day	Labor Day
Columbus Day	Veterans Day
Thanksgiving Day	Christmas

...and other days specifically declared by the President of the United States to be National Holidays. Contractor may request alternate work hours and work days in writing to the contracting officer.
