

B.2 SCHEDULE OF PRICING

PROVIDE AGENCY SUPPLEMENTAL NURSING SERVICES on an as-needed basis to the Lexington VA Medical Center, from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 with the option for extending services as listed below. Nursing personnel shall be provided to cover various rotations of shifts during vacancies and absences of Government nursing personnel.

B.2.1. Award will be based on best value to the Lexington, KY Veterans Affairs Medical Center (VAMC). The Government reserves the right to award without discussions, based on initial offers received. Contractor shall be required to maintain a pool of credentialed candidates to respond on an as needed basis throughout the full contract period of performance. All services are to be provided on-site at any of the Lexington VAMC facilities including the two VAMC medical center facilities and all Veteran Administration Clinics (VA Clinics). The majority of services shall be provided at the two VAMC facilities however services may be needed from time to time at any of the VA Clinic locations. (See Performance Work Statement (PWS) paragraph 1.1.1 for identification and addresses of all facilities.) Under the authority of Public Law 104-262 and 38 USC 8153, the contractor agrees to provide Health Care Resources in accordance with the terms and conditions stated herein, to furnish to and at the Lexington Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center, the services and prices specified in the Section entitled Schedule of Pricing of this contract.

B.2.2. ESTIMATED QUANTITIES: The total estimated number of hours over the 5 year period shall not exceed 286,800. The guaranteed minimum contract amount for the IDIQ contract for the base year and any option years is 360 hours and the maximum contract amounts including the base year and any option years exercised shall not exceed 286,800 hours. As multiple awards are anticipated, the guaranteed minimum will be divided between all Awardees.

B.2.3. ORDERS: Orders: This is a Firm Fixed Price (FFP) Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract (see FAR 52.216-22). Task Orders shall be placed against this IDIQ contract at the time of contract award on an as needed basis. The Contracting Officer assigned to the contract or assigned to administer the contract shall be the only personnel that may issue Task Orders.

B.2.4. ORDERING PROCEDURES:

- a. This contract type allows the Veteran Affairs Network Contracting Office (NCO 9) contracting officers to place orders with the Contractors on an as needed basis. In accordance with the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Clauses 52.216-18, Ordering. NCO 9 will obligate the funding and order the services by issuing a task order.
- b. The Contractor shall initiate work when, so directed by a Task Order issued by the Contracting Officer. No work under any Task Order shall be performed unless specifically authorized by the Contracting Officer. Approval of a Task Order shall not constitute approval to exceed any item listed in the contract or general provisions of the contract. The total dollar amount of all task Orders shall not exceed the overall Maximum Order Limitation (MOL) provided in FAR Clause 52.216-19(b)(2). The contractor shall not exceed the estimated task order amount, or change the task order without prior written approval of the Contracting Officer.
- c. In event the Contractors are unable to fulfill the task order requirements for whatever reason; the government reserves the right to fulfill its need outside of this contract. A written confirmation

from the contractor indicating the inability to fulfill the task order is immediately required. The quantity of hours ordered on the unfilled task order will be applied to the minimum quantity. The government's right to fulfill its need outside this contract(s) does not waive its right to the issuance of a cure notice nor does it waive its right to terminate for default.

Submitted pricing shall be ALL INCLUSIVE of services provided, training of Lexington nursing staff, equipment and/or supplies needed, and all applicable fees associated with performing the services in accordance with the requirements of this contract. These services are on an as needed/ if needed basis, and the contractor will only be compensated for procedures performed.

THE AWARD OF MULTIPLE CONTRACTS IS ANTICIPATED. Awards will be made in descending order. The highest ranked offeror will be Contractor 1; the second highest ranked offeror will be Contractor 2, and so on. There is no guarantee that any number of awards will be made. **Due to the fact that multiple awards are anticipated, the amount of work each Contractor shall receive cannot be anticipated or guaranteed outside of the guaranteed minimum as stated in Section B.2.2.** The VA COR will make requests for nursing personnel from Contractors and will be rotated between awardee's. Award will be subject to the availability of funding.

The period of performance is a Base Year from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017 with four (4) possible option years.

Changes may only be made by a written modification which is formally executed by the contractor and Contracting Officer.
