


3 SECOND FLOOR, QUENCH VENT ROUTE

NOTES:

PHASING

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT A PLAN AND SCHEDULE TO THE CONTRACTING OFFICER IDENTIFYING THE PRECISE LOCATION AND INSTALLATION SEQUENCE OF ALL TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOT BEGIN WORK PRIOR TO RECEIVING AUTHORIZATION FROM CONTRACTING OFFICER.
2. IF WORK IN CERTAIN DEPARTMENTS NEED TO BE SUB-PHASED THE CONTRACTOR MAY NEED TO LOCATE ADDITIONAL TEMPORARY PARTITIONS TO SEPARATE THESE AREAS. FINAL CONTRIBUTION AND PLACEMENT CONTINGENT ON FINAL AUTHORIZATION BY CONTRACTING OFFICER. DOORS SHALL BE SOLID CORE, LOCKABLE AND WELL SEALED.
3. EGRESS PATH SHALL BE MAINTAINED DURING SCHEDULED WORK.
4. TEMPORARY PARTITIONS SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED AS REQUIRED TO SEPARATE OCCUPIED AREAS OF THE HOSPITAL FROM CONSTRUCTION WORK AREAS. PROVIDE PARTITION TYPE "F" FROM FLOOR TO CEILING ABOVE.

MRI

1. DOOR AND DOOR FRAMES MAY REQUIRE TEMPORARY REMOVAL TO FACILITATE MAGNET DELIVERY. IN THIS CASE CONTRACTOR WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REINSTALLATION OF THESE ITEMS AND PERFORM THE WORK REQUIRED TO RESTORE THE ORIGINAL CONDITIONS.
2. PROTECT ALL EXISTING FINISHES ALONG DELIVERY ROUTE.
