This opportunity is 100% Set Aside for Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVSB) only.

Solicitation Documents will NOT be available for downloading until approximately January 31, 2017.

## **SCOPE**

This requirement will be a Firm Fixed Price Construction project to Remove and replace existing Obsolete Fire Alarm Devices and associated electrical circuits at the Jesse Brown VA Medical Center, located in Chicago, Illinois.

The Contractor shall provide all tools, materials, components, labor, management and supervision to remove and replace existing Obsolete Fire Alarm Devices and associated electrical circuits at Jesse Brown VA Medical Center (JBVA), 820 S. Damen Avenue in Buildings #1, #5, #11, #15, #18, #21, #30, #32 (Temporary Metal Building), #40 and #42 Chicago, Illinois, as outlined herein and as per the attached pdf. Project Specifications Document.

The anticipated Period of Performance shall be one hundred ninety-seven (197) calendar days from the Notice to Proceed date.

The NAICS code for this procurement is 236220 with a size standard of \$36.5 million dollars. The magnitude of construction project range is between \$1,000,000 and \$5,000,000.

Bid, Performance and Payment Bonds will be required.

Pursuant to Public Law 109-461, Solicitation VA69D-17-R-0024 will be issued as a 100% Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) Set-aside. In order to be considered for award, the contractor shall be CVE-Verified as an SDVOSB vendor in <https://www.vip.vetbiz.gov> by the date and time specified for receipt of proposals. No other sources will be considered. All interested parties submitting a bid must be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) database (<https://www.sam.gov/prtal/public/SAM>) at time of submission. SAM is the Official U.S. Government system that consolidated the capabilities of CCR/FedReg, ORCA, and EPLS. SAM is used as a means to provide basic business information, socioeconomic status, capabilities and financial information to the Government. This requirement will apply to all solicitations and awards, regardless of the media use.

This Pre-Solicitation notice is **NOT** a request for proposals or submittals of any kind. The Department of Veterans Affairs plans to issue the official solicitation by December 30, 2016 with the bid opening in late January 2017.

The Department of Veterans Affairs intends on issuing the solicitation via the [FedBizOpps.gov](https://www.fbo.gov) website ([www.fbo.gov](http://www.fbo.gov)).
