

Custom Domiciliary Bed Frames “Mental Health Hospital Bed Frames”

Quantity: Total of 133

*19 Each to be delivered as soon as feasible (activation funds)

*114 Each (Building 9- 33 beds, Building 2-1st floor- 6 beds, Building 2-2nd floor-75 beds)

Home-like appearance (non-institutional)

Solid Wood construction only – No Veneer

Overall bed frame approximately 40”W x 85”L x 31”H to include a head board and a foot board

Bunk Board/Platform approximately 35.50” x 80.50” (houses the mattress)

Must fit our stock mattress size of 35”W x 80”L x 6.5”H

Clear Maple finish (to match existing furniture)

Bed platform must be made of sealed plywood to prevent fluids from entering cracks and crevices (Chip board or compressed particle board is Not acceptable)

Platform must hold a minimum of 400 pounds for 8 hours repetitively

Minimum of 3” lockable, non-marking casters with sealed ball bearings (4 for each frame)

No sharp edges and all external components should be securely mounted

Bed frames need to withstand continuous use of disinfectants already being utilized by the VA Spic & Span Disinfecting All-Purpose Spray and Glass Cleaner by Procter and Gamble (FH/H/2005/JWJA-6JNPT2) and Virex II 256 (US) by Johnson Diversey (4329)

Vendor shall provide written instructions and/or procedures on how to properly and safely disinfect bed frame or verify that it can withstand VA disinfectant cleaners

Vendor is required to provide a drawing to include dimensions of the proposed frame

Vendor is required to provide product/materials listing of proposed bed frame

Vendor shall provide on-site disassembly of old bed frames
(VA employees will pick up disassembled bed frames)

Vendor shall provide on-site assembly and installation of new bed frames

Vendor shall dispose of all material waste and packaging associated with the bed frames during installation

The vendor may work from 8:00am until 4:30 pm - Monday through Friday in order to complete this work. (Not on federal holiday)

NOTE: Bed frames may be delivered and installed in phases due to resident occupancy; dates and schedule arrangements will be made with the VA Point of Contact.
