SPECIAL NOTICE TO SDVOSB Contractors

- (1) Please take notice that 25% of the LABOR force provided by the successful contractor must be provided by the SDVOSB's construction employees, that said SDVOSB administrative staff does not count toward that 25% requirement. Per VAAR 852.219-10.
 - (2) SDVOSB contractors must have actual company construction employees on their payroll and the number of employees must be reflected in the CCR and on your Dun and Bradstreet report.
 - (3) The SDVOSB program was not established to be used as a “store front” or on “pass through” basis, the Service Disabled Veteran company must be running the day to day business operations and have 100% decision making authority.
 - (4) Bidders must have the proper NAICS code loaded in their CCR file as well as the company ORCA registration must reflect the proper NAICS code.
 - (5) The Contracting Officer will perform a thorough review of the SDVOSB contractor business status prior to award, should any inconsistencies or failure to have the proper certifications recorded it may result in disqualification.
