

Statement of Work

Background:

This equipment request is for the North Florida South Georgia Veteran Health System (NF/SG VHS) for the new VA Tallahassee Outpatient Clinic (THCC) activation. Currently, NFSG owns a Motorola K2 Core System and by procuring fifteen (15) new portable Motorola APX 7000, dual band, digital radios and installation of all supporting equipment, it will allow the Medical Center to have interoperability for cost effectiveness. Purchase to include all Motorola intersystem equipment/hardware, programming, software applications and AES encryption. The system shall be FCC Project 25 (P25) compliant and compatible for public safety requirements and emergency responders.

Objective:

This equipment purchase is to provide a digital radio system for the Tallahassee remote RF site to be used daily by Tallahassee Outpatient Clinic (TOPC) VA Police with capability to communicate with Fire Rescue, Emergency Medical Services and First Responders, and have interoperability with VA Police at the Malcom Randall VA Medical Center, Gainesville, Florida. Radio system shall provide communication for VA Police within the TOPC clinical setting, parking and grounds area and during emergencies activations or events. A roof mounted Omni bio directional antenna is required and shall meet all Florida State Codes for Hurricane wind shear load. System requires integration via a Conventional Gateway Channel to allow interoperability via government provided IP network from TOPC to existing Motorola IP based ASTRO 25 K2 Core VHF Conventional system at the Gainesville VA Medical Center. All equipment shall be installed per manufacturer's recommendation by a certified contractor. The vendor shall be authorized by the manufacturer to sell and maintain these digital radios. Equipment and installation standard warranties are required.

Place of Performance RF site: Tallahassee Outpatient Clinic, 2181 East Orange Ave, Tallahassee, FL 32301. Blue prints of TOPC will be provided. Facility is a 3 story building. VA police operations office is located on the first floor, room 1M102.

ASTRO K2 Core site: Malcom Randall VA Medical Center, 1601 SW Archer Road, Gainesville, FL 32608.

Safety Regulations:

- Ensure system meet meets all industry standards, specifications and guidelines. (USPC, OSHA, JCAHO, NFPA, DEA and the FDA)
- The VA Safety Officer shall have full authority to see that the contractor obeys all safety rules and regulations relative to the fulfillment of this contract.
