Other Than Full and Open Competition

1. **Contracting Activity:** Department of Veterans Affairs, VISN 4, James E. Van Zandt VA Medical Center – Station 503

2. **Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed:**

Purchase of two (2) Sterrad NX sterilizers for Sterile Processing Services to replace the existing Ethylene Oxide (EtO) Sterilizers. Included should be installation and validation, in-service, and one (1) year warranty.

Background:

Sterilization is currently performed using EtO. Per VHA Directive 2011-015, existing EtO sterilizers are required to have air pollution devices (Abators) installed by October 1, 2014. The projected cost of this equipment is estimated at \$25,000 - \$30,000 plus installation costs. At that point the Medical Center decided to review other alternatives to sterilization of equipment.

3. **Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs:**

The Medical Center endoscopes/cystoscopes must be sterilized. Tables 6.1 and 6.2 (attached) show compatible methods that can be used with our existing Olympus scopes. Of the 5 methods shown only EtO and Sterrad NX are sterilizers, while the other three (3) are disinfectants. Between the two (2) remaining, the Sterrad NX is preferred from an environmental stand point because EtO is a proven carcinogen and requires dedicated exhaust and monitoring.

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The Sterrad NX system is the only other system compatible with our existing scopes as stated above and shown on the attached tables 6.1 and 6.2. The benefit is that it is environmentally friendly.

6. **Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as deemed practicable:**

Sources are limited due to the compatible methods of sterilizing. EtO and Sterrad NX are the only two (2) systems compatible with our existing scopes.

7. **Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair and Reasonable:**

Pricing was requested for Sterrad NX equipment. The pricing was reviewed by engineering and compared to actual costs for a Sterrad NX 100 system that was recently installed at the Wilkes-Barre VAMC.

8. **Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons Market Research Was Not Conducted:**


Market Research was conducted to review alternatives to the EtO. The only alternative, as mentioned above, was to purchase the Sterrad system.




