Note for optional line items: The vendors will provide pricing for reserve containers based on a weekly basis. This will allow us to add reserve containers into the flat monthly rate as they are needed throughout the performance of this contract. For example, if a 32 gallon container was needed and the weekly amount was \$10, then we would calculate how many weeks are remaining in the current contract period and a mod would be processed to order that optional line item. The price schedule for any remaining option periods would also be adjusted to reflect the new flat monthly rate. The quantities for the optional line items are estimates and as they are ordered the price schedule will be revised to reflect the new flat monthly rate going forward.
