**1. BACKGROUND**

The contractor shall provide all labor, tools, and supplies to install the Temp Trak temperature monitoring system at various designated locations of the VASDHS.

**4. DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES**

1. Install 5 Cooper Atkins Intelli-base buffer and receiver
2. Install 7 Cooper Atkins repeaters
3. Install 278 Cooper Atkins 900Mhz transmitters
4. Install Cooper Atkins TempTrak Enterprise Software
5. Install Cooper Atkins Intelligent Insights

**3. GOVERNMENT FURNISHED PROPERTY**

The government will provide the TempTrak temperature monitoring system.

**4. OTHER REQUIREMENTS**

- a. The contractor shall comply with all applicable Federal, State, and local requirements regarding workers' health and safety. These requirements include, but are not limited to, those found in Federal and State Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) statutes and regulations, such as applicable provisions of Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Parts 1910 and 1926, NFPA 70E, Article 130.7 29 CFR 1910.132(d)(1)(iii), 29 CFR1910.137
- b. The contractor shall provide all necessary tools, and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to perform the work safely, effectively, and timely.
- c. All necessary precautions shall be taken by the contractor to prevent accidental operation of any existing smoke detectors or sprinkler heads.
- d. No flammable liquids shall be stored or used in the medical center for a duration period greater the time scheduled to perform the work.

- e. The medical services at the designated locations will remain operational during the execution of this work; Contractor shall take all precautions to minimize disruption to daily routine tasks performed in those services. Patients care shall remain a top concern for the Contractor and his employees while performing the work.

**5. INSPECTION AND ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA**

The VA can perform inspection of the work performed without the presence of the contractor and determine whether the work performed is within standards expressed in this scope of work. It is the VA's prerogative to hire an independent qualified third party to check the validity of the work conducted.

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
