It is paramount to match the other existing pumps in the system with an exact replacement. This is necessary for connection/bolt-in hook-up and the existing pump controls must match the replacement pump. Estimated cost for a completely new replacement system is in excess of \$22,000.00.

Warranty issues for second hand parts is not an option, due to we only want a new exact replacement part.

4. DESCRIPTION OF MARKET RESEARCH CONDUCTED AND RESULTS OR STATEMENT WHY IT WAS NOT CONDUCTED:

Weinman is the only company that makes this pump, but other small businesses can purchase and install this pump. The replacement pump must be an exact replacement to ensure correct connection/bolt-in hook-up and system control connections.

Engineering has an existing inventory of parts for minor repairs to the system and to attempt to install a pump which is not an exact replacement will be result in an additional cost to the government to include a huge cost to modify existing piping system to accept a pump which is not an exact replacement. (Estimated cost is an additional \$22,000.00 to modify the existing piping system). If the system is modified to accommodate non matching pumps, the next pump failure will require a total replacement. Estimated cost for a total replacement system is in excess of \$22,000.00.
