

Q1: What are the socioeconomic standard(s) requirements to submit a proposal on this RFP?

A1: This is a total set-aside for Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB). Each contractor will be verified in System Award Management (SAM), Small Business Administration (SBA) and Vendor Information Pages (VIP). Proposals will be considered nonresponsive and rejected if the Contracting Officer is not able to verify and view contractor registrations.

Q2: Will winning bidder if out of State be given grace period to add Texas Security License or can a Joint Venture be pursued with qualified existing Texas Security Companies that may not be a Veteran Service Disabled Company ?

A2: This is a total set-aside for Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB), and no grace period will be given to contractors from outside of Texas. Each contractor will be treated the same no matter which state they're located in.

Q3: Is there an existing Project Manager and guards currently working this project?

A3: No

Q4: Is there currently a Service Disabled Veteran Security Guard Company working this Project?

A4: No

Q5: Will this 5 year project require a vehicle?

A5: No, patrol will be made on foot only.
