Justification and Approval (J&A) For Other Than Full and Open Competition (>\$150K)

- 1. <u>Contracting Activity</u>: Department of Veterans Affairs, VISN 6, and Network Contracting Office (NCO) 6, Veteran Affairs.
- 2. Nature and/or Description of the Action Being Processed: The purpose of this justification is to request sole source approval for a short- term (5 month base + 1 (6) month option) bridge contract with the incumbent contractor/manufacturer. This is procurement for custom surgical procedure bundles; issued in accordance with FAR 13.5 Simplified Procedures for accordance with FAR 13.5 for Certain Commercial Items. Specifically FAR 13.501 Special Documentation Requirements, where acquisitions conducted under Simplified Acquisition Procedures are exempt from the requirements of FAR Part 6, but still require a justification using the format of FAR 6.303-2.
- 3. Description of Supplies/Services Required to Meet the Agency's Needs: The Richmond VAMC has a repetitive requirement for custom bundles to be utilized within the operating room. The custom bundles are made up of individually selected components, specific to the facility where they are used. The bundles are assembled by a manufacturer, sterilized, and shipped to the Richmond VA Medical Center. The current contract has expired and there is an imminent need to continue service to support patient care. The Independent Government Estimate is \$412,618.
- 4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other than Full and Open Competition:

- 5. Demonstration that the Contractor's Unique Qualifications or Nature of the Acquisition Requires the Use of the Authority Cited Above (applicability of authority): Due to the time required to adjust to a different manufacturer, there are serval compelling reasons to sole source this short term contract until a new contract can be awarded. Changing pack manufacturers, components, or distributors initially takes approximately 120 days to allow the new contractor lead time to stock all required components. Manus Medical LLC is the only known vendor which has the specialized products readily available at this time that meets VAMC Richmond requirement for very specific precision surgical procedures. This contract is intended to ensure supply to the facility while a long-term, regional procurement is being protested at the Service Area Office (SAO) Central VA Contracting Office.

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6. <u>Description of Efforts Made to ensure that offers are solicited from as many potential sources as</u> deemed practicable:

In order to maintain patient services at VAMC Richmond, competition among more than one source is deemed impracticable at this time due to the assembly lead-in time requirement noted in paragraph five. This justification relates solely to the need of ensuring a contractual vehicle is in place pending the execution of a long-term solution.

7. <u>Determination by the Contracting Officer that the Anticipated Cost to the Government will be Fair</u> and Reasonable:

Pricing for the custom packs is considered fair and reasonable based on published pricing of individual components and on historical procurements.

8. <u>Description of the Market Research Conducted and the Results, or a Statement of the Reasons</u> Market Research Was Not Conducted:

Market research indicates providers other than Manus Medical LLC may reasonably be able to meet the requirement. However, for the reasons stated above, undue delays incurred by the competitive process are not allowable at this time, as there are no gains to be realized by competition that would offset the potentially serious consequences of not having product readily available for routine and/or emergency surgical procedures at VAMC Richmond. It is anticipated the upcoming Facility requirement for custom surgical packs will be solicited using Full and Open Competition.
